

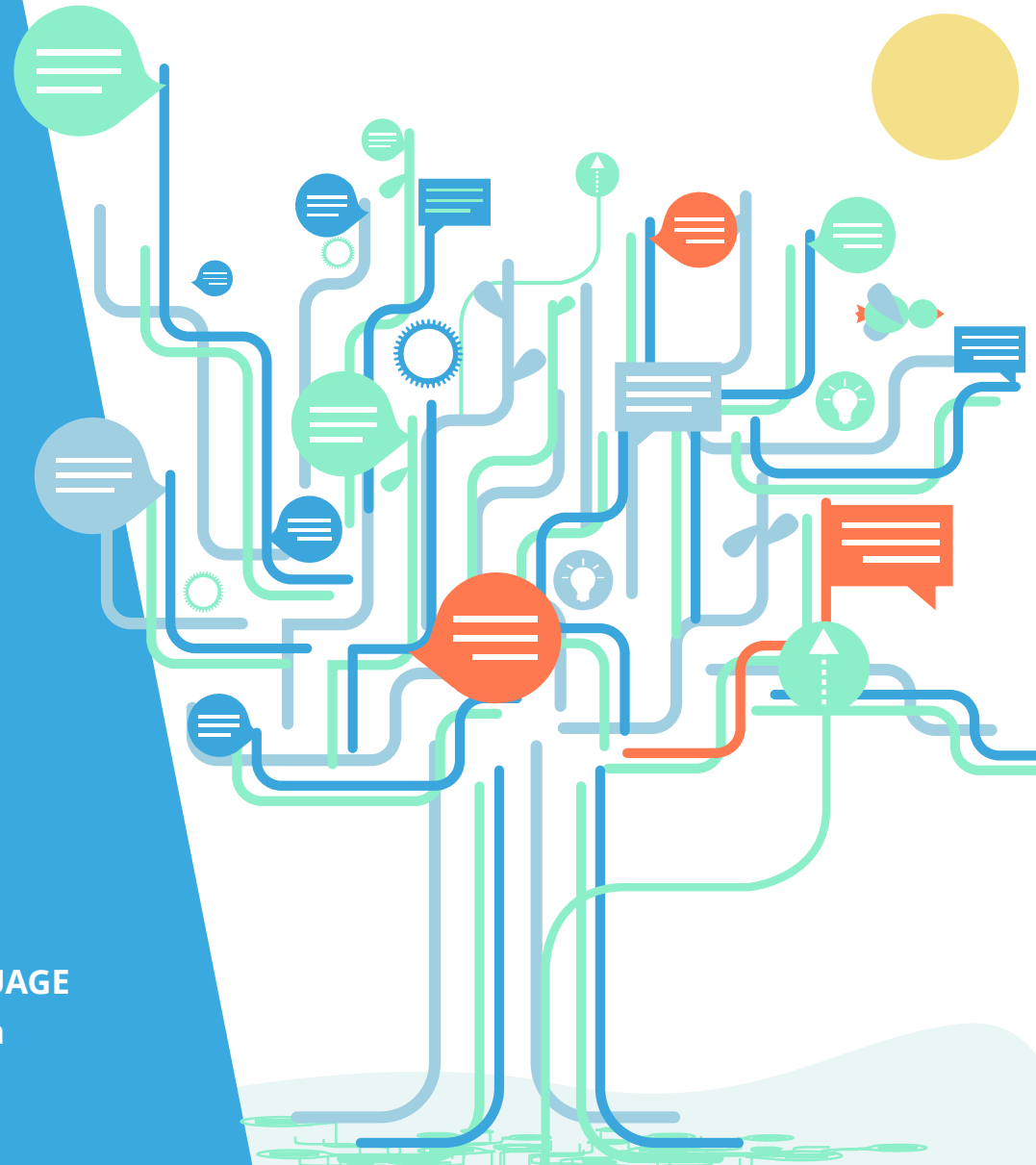

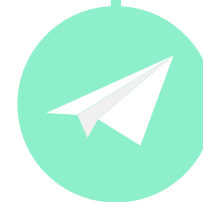


## Goals
