

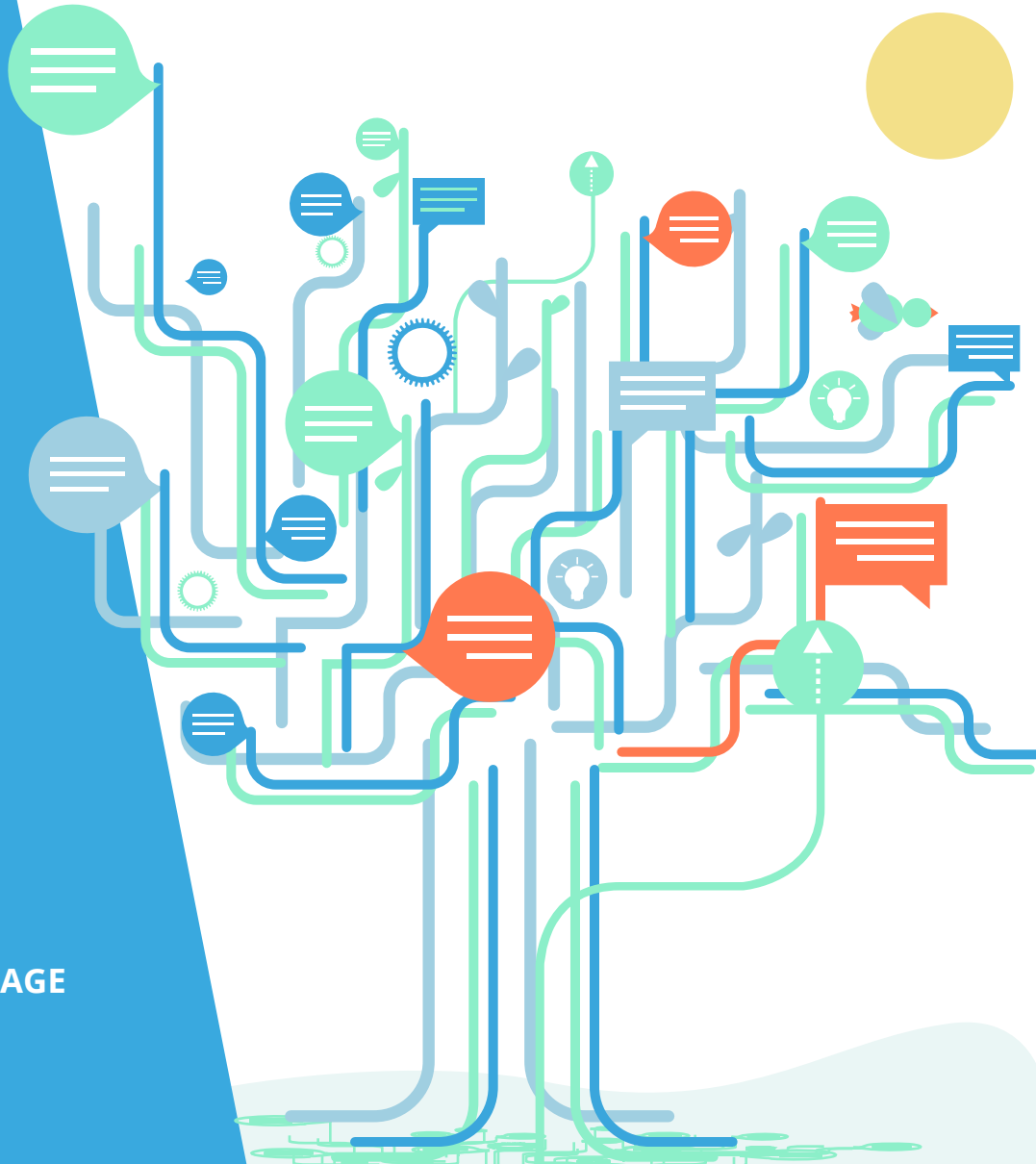

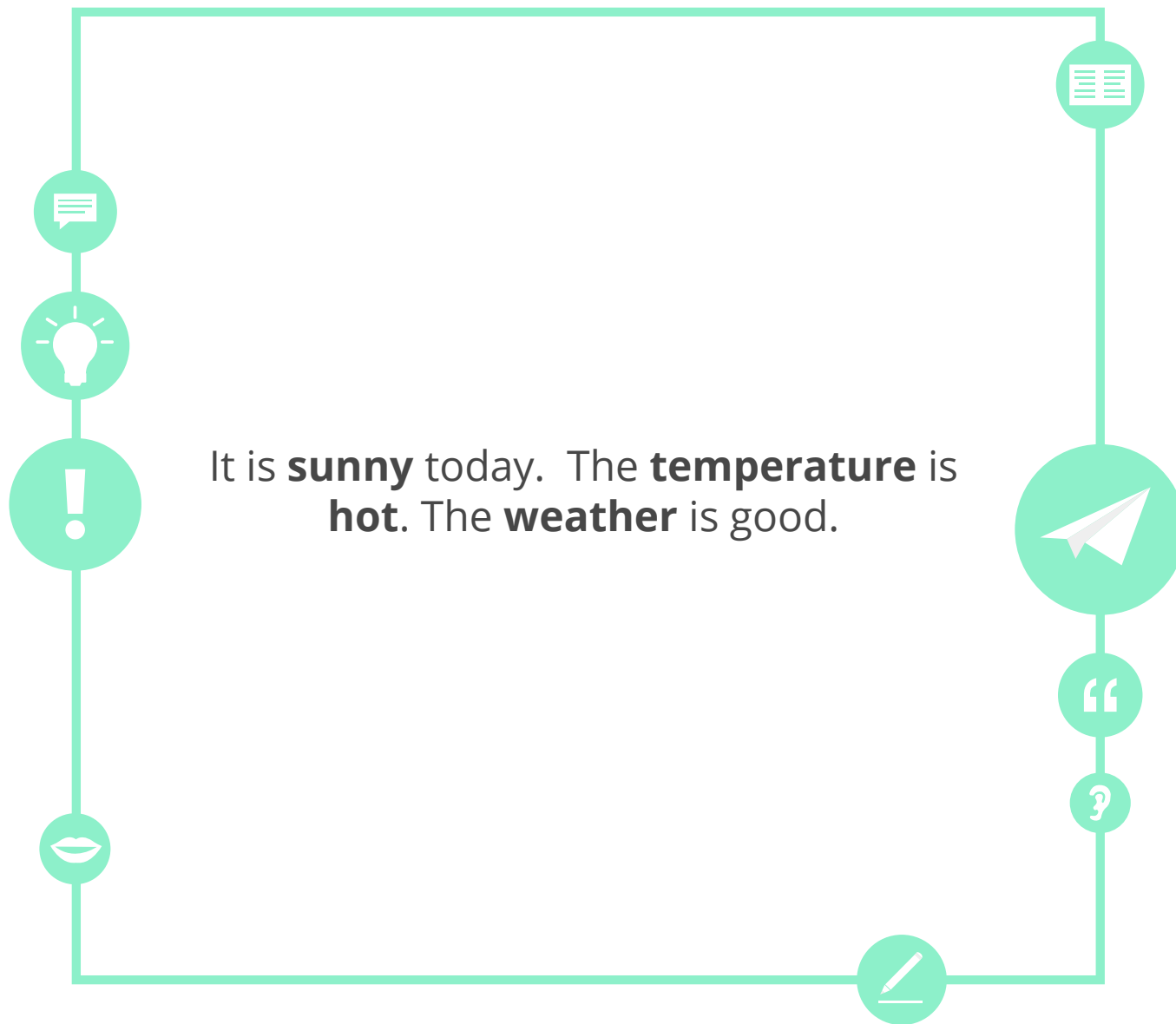




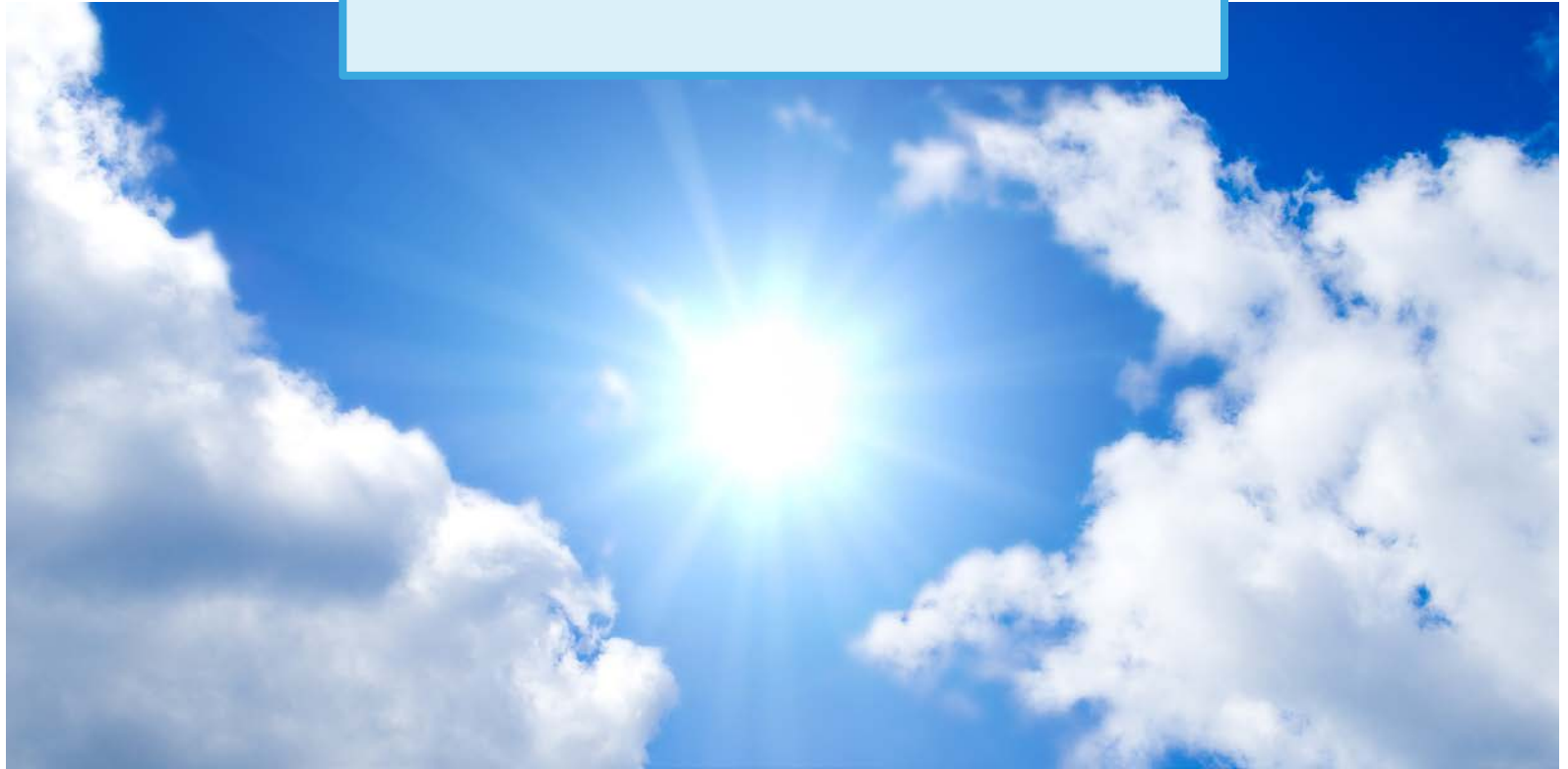
## Goals

- Can identify a range of familiar weather phenomena.



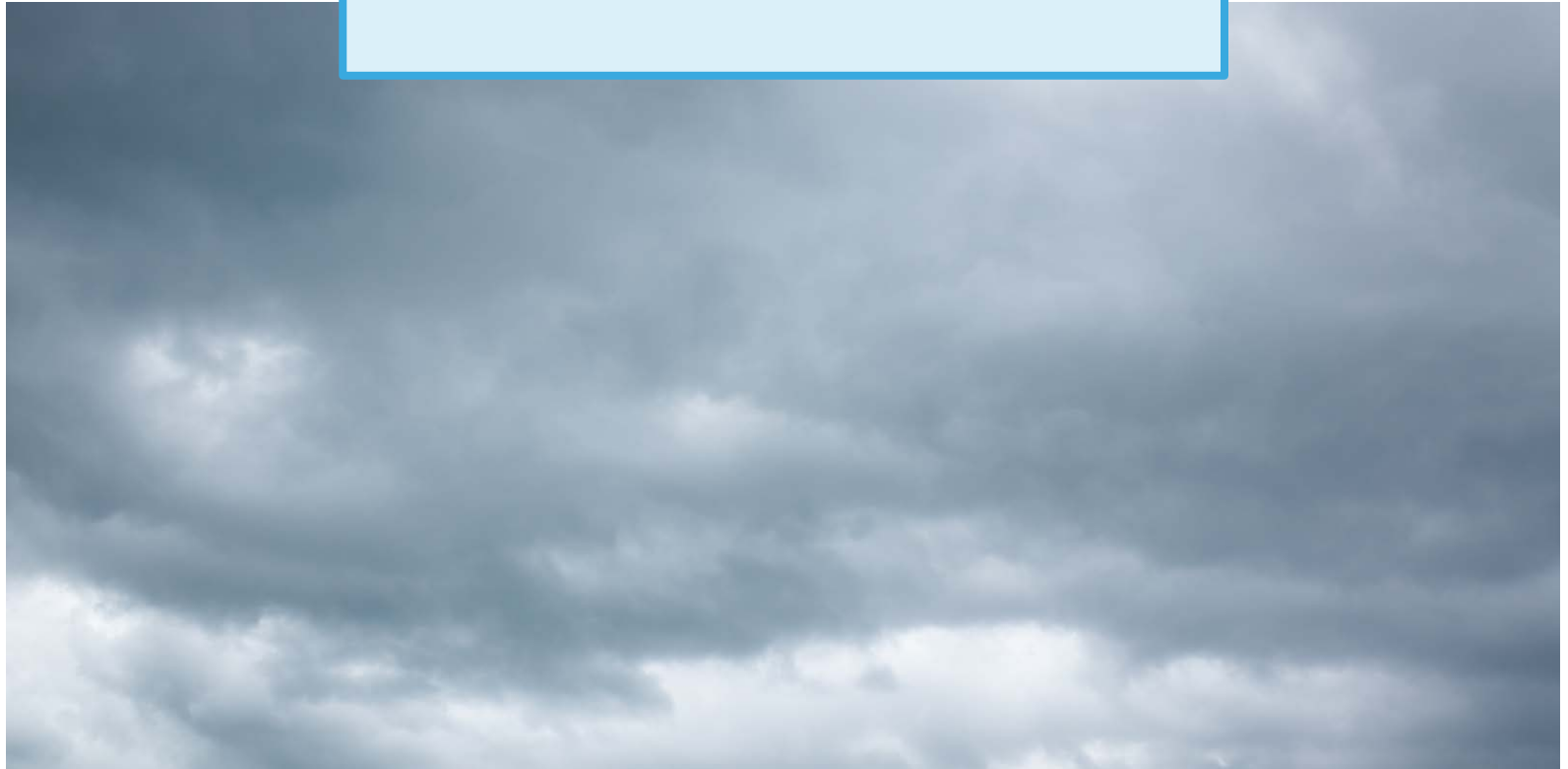

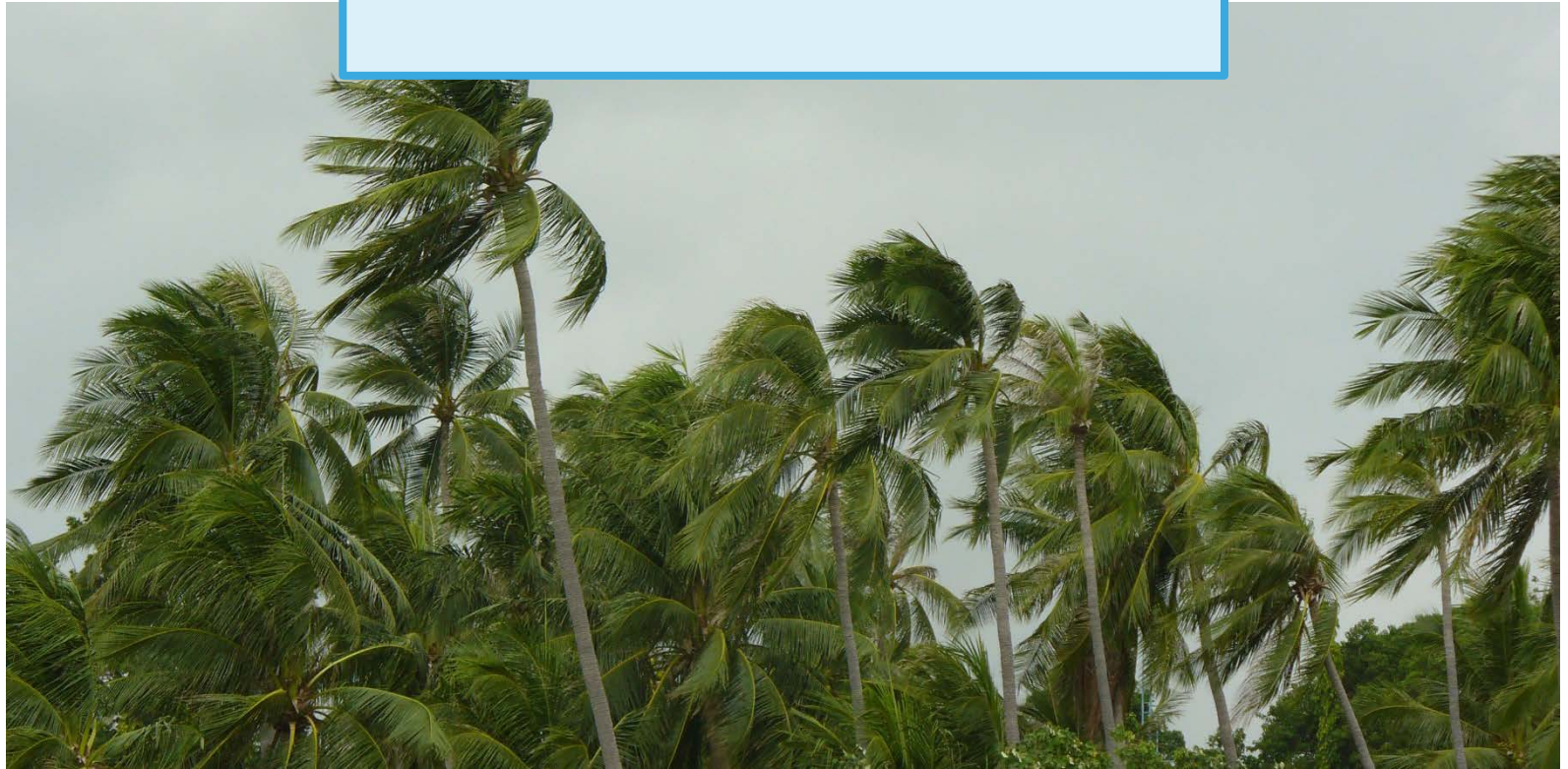
It is **sunny** today.

cloudy



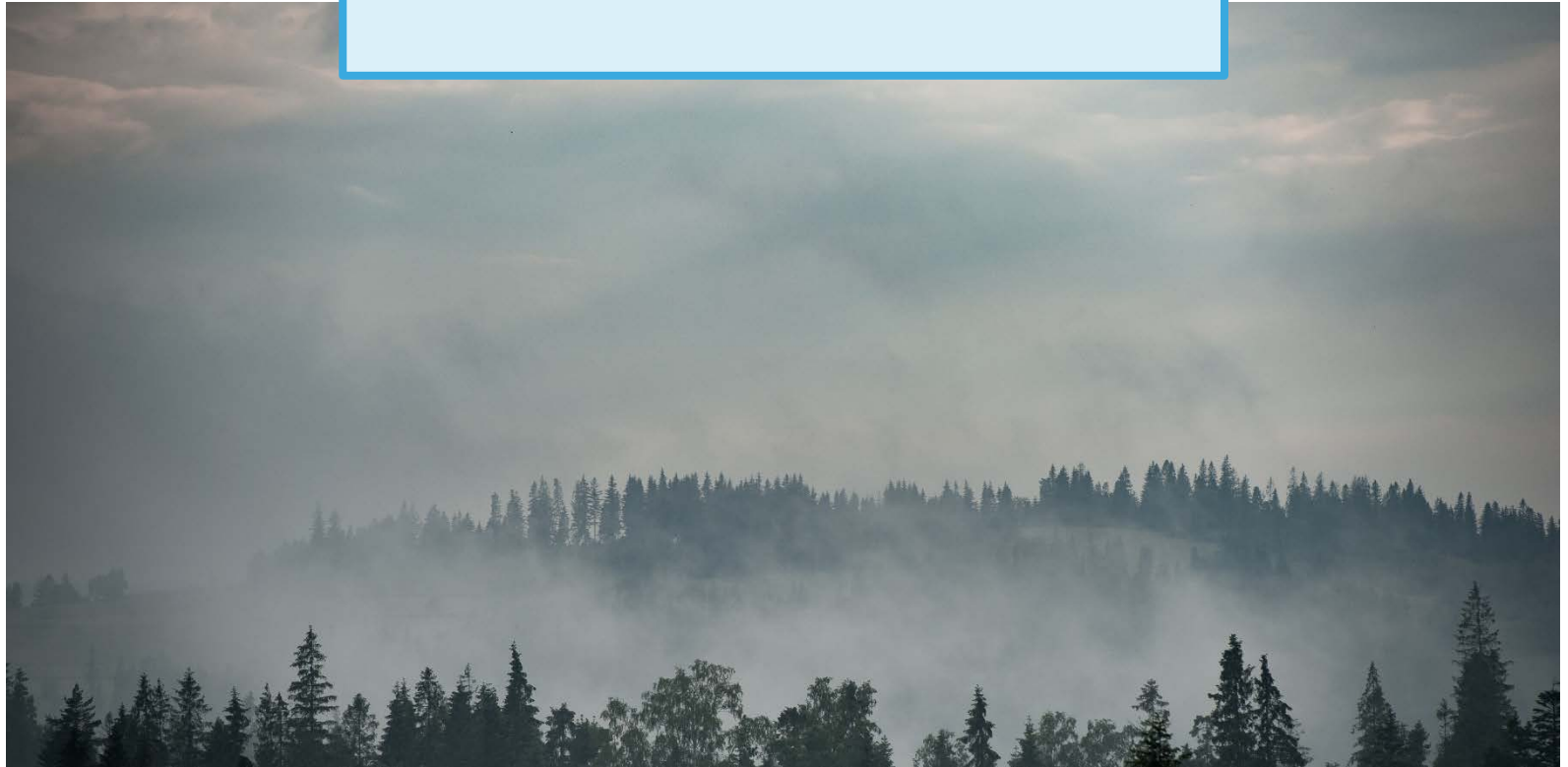
It is **cloudy** today.

It is **windy** today.

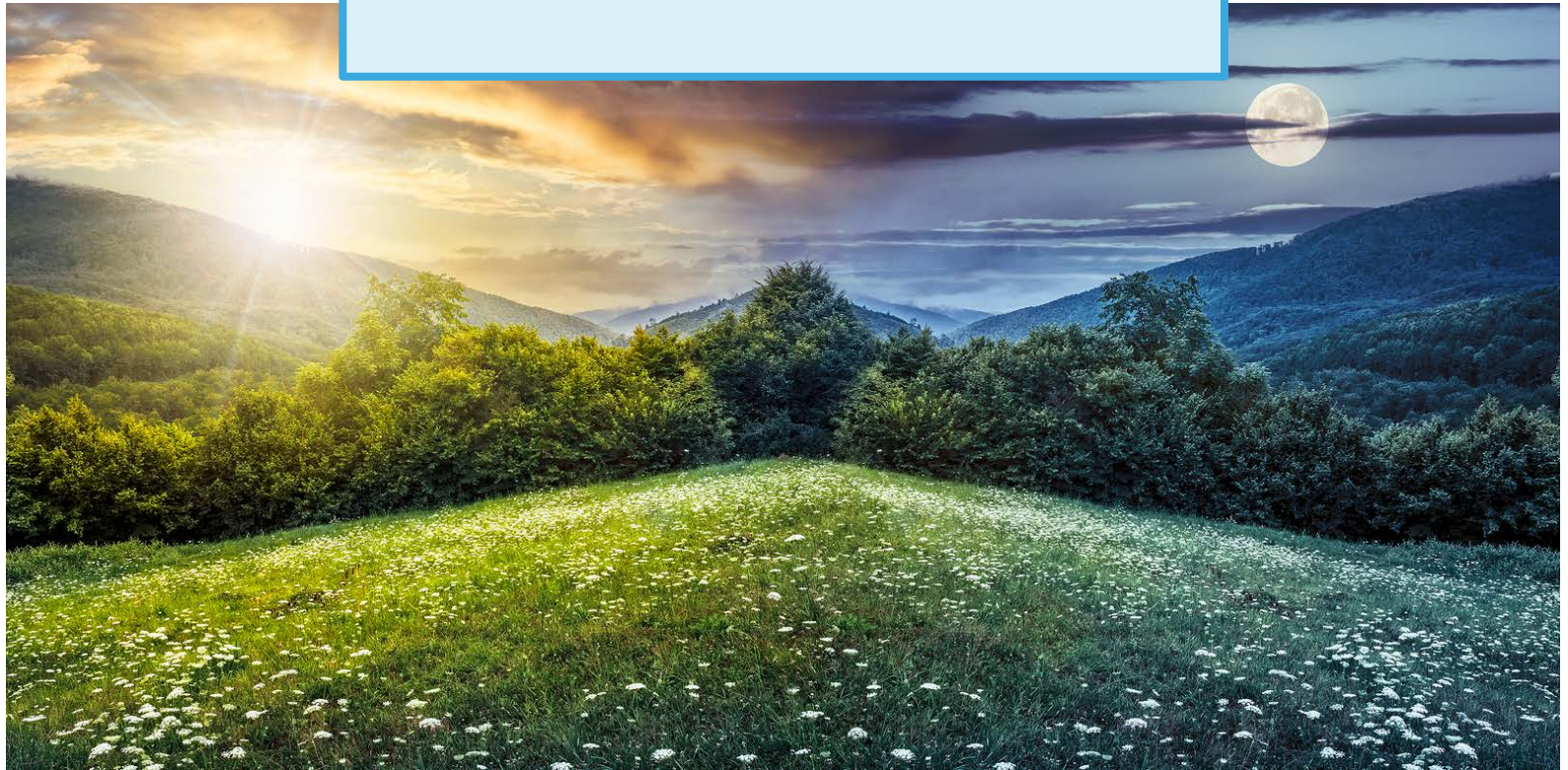
foggy

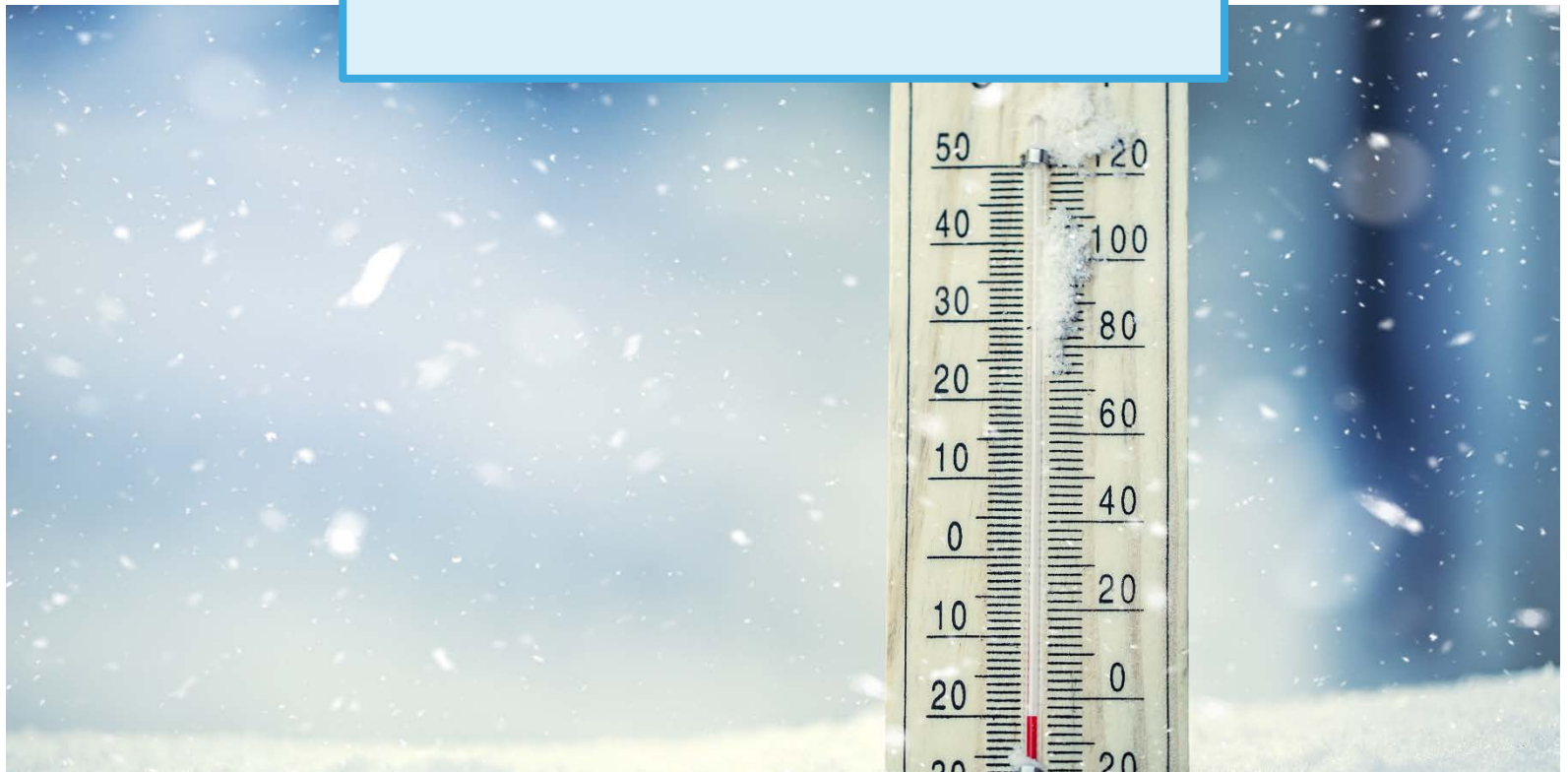

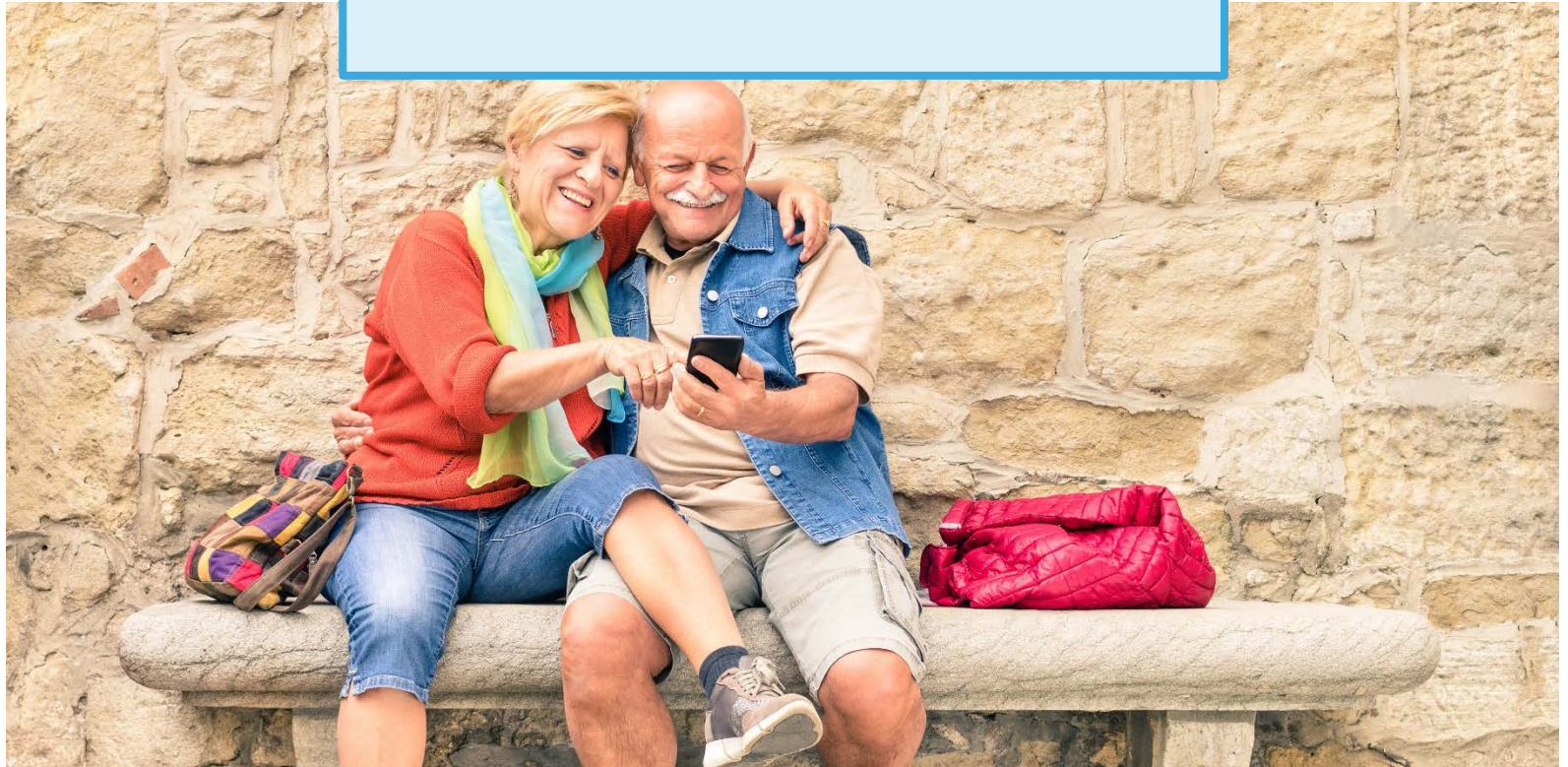

It's **cold** in the winter.

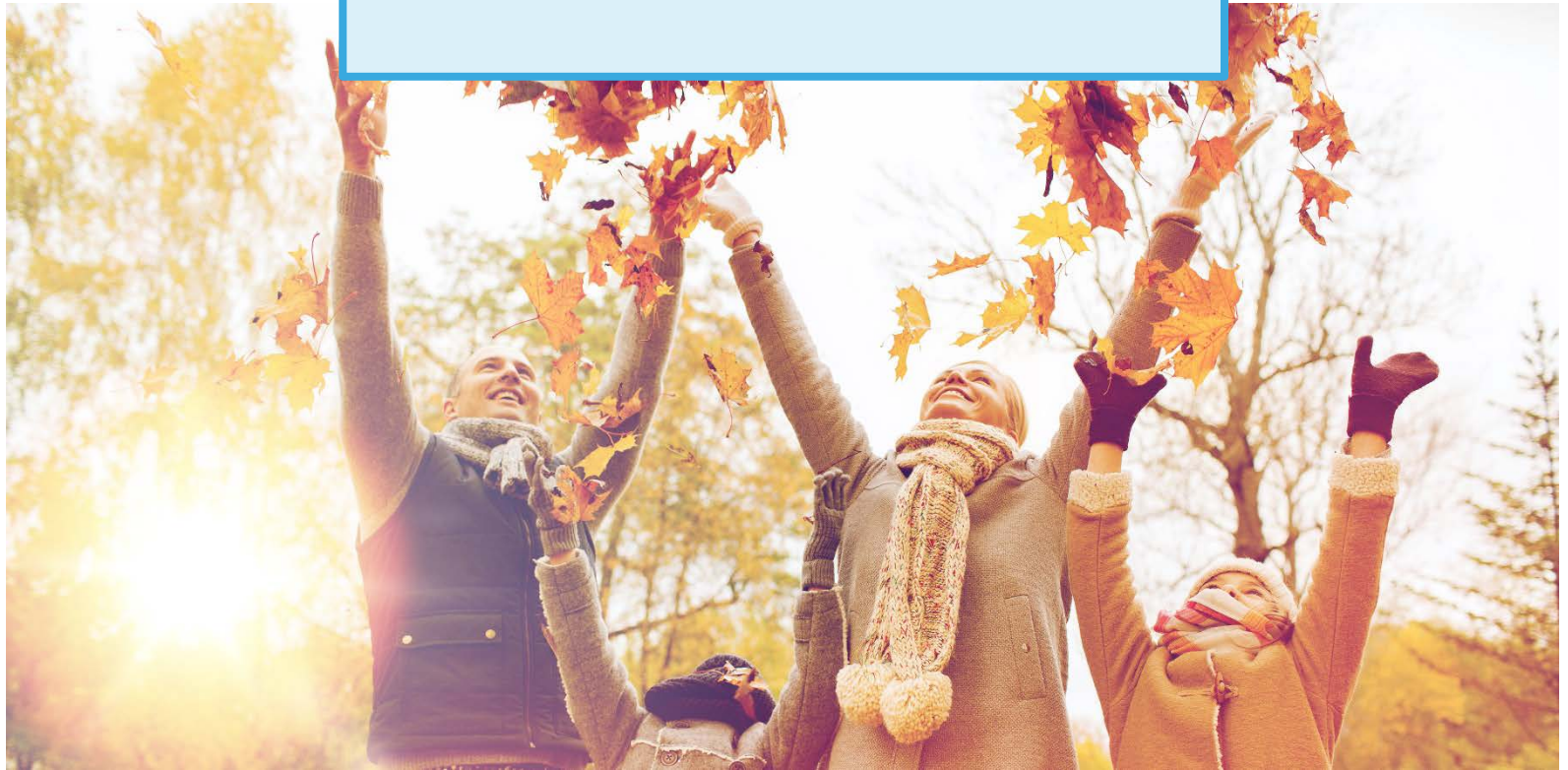
warm
