

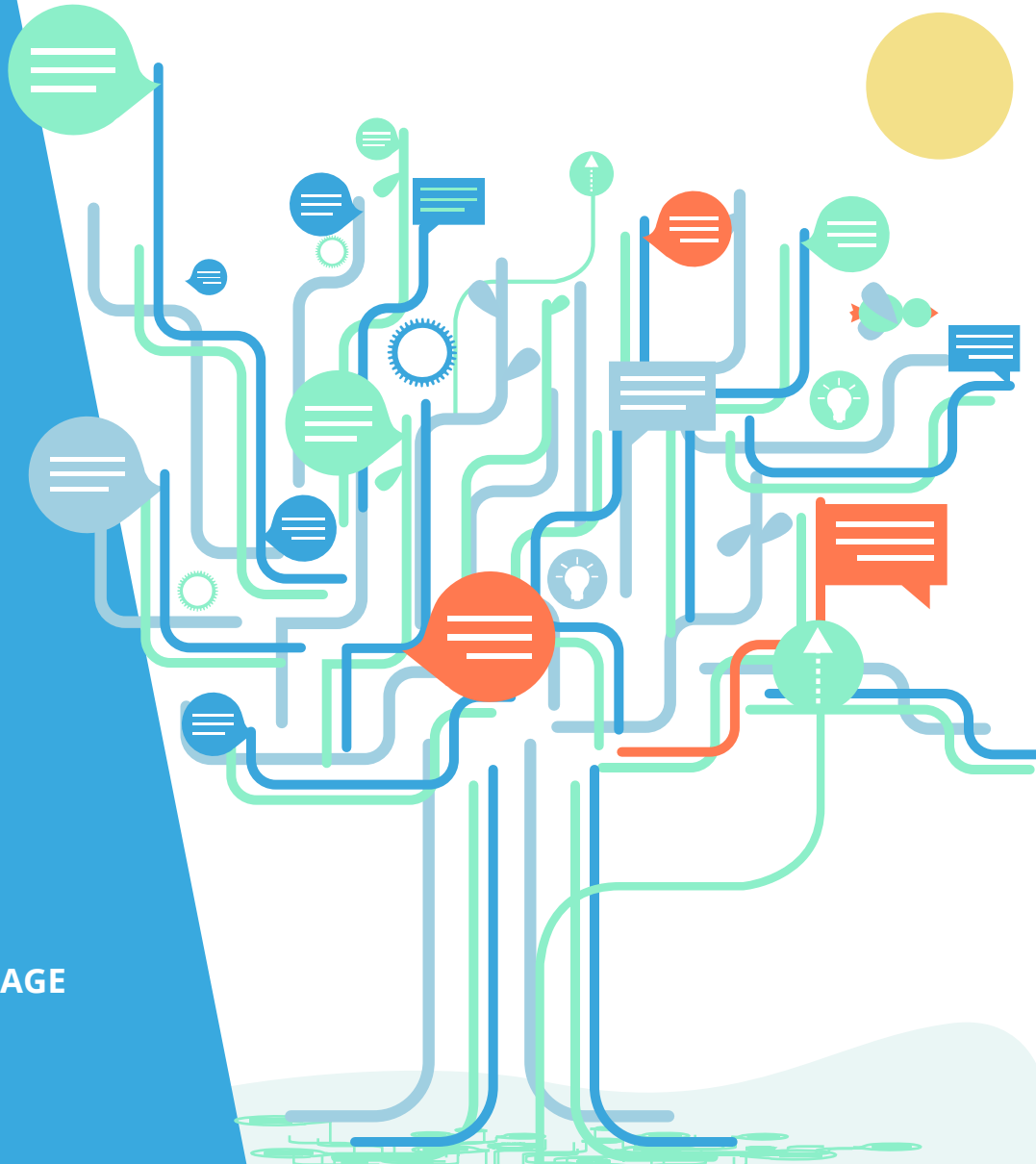

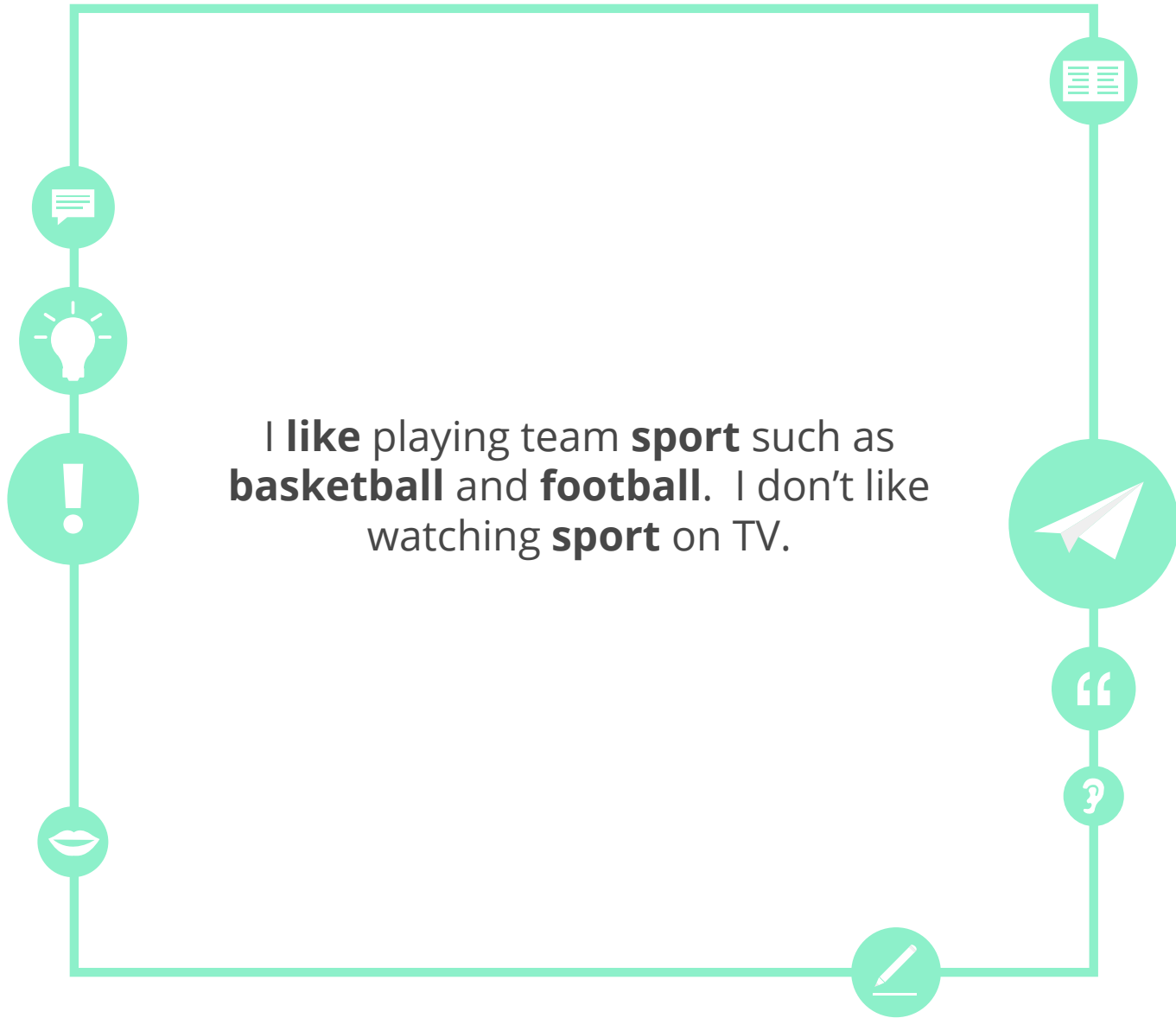


Goals

I **like** playing team **sport** such as **basketball** and **football**. I don't like watching **sport** on TV.



to ski



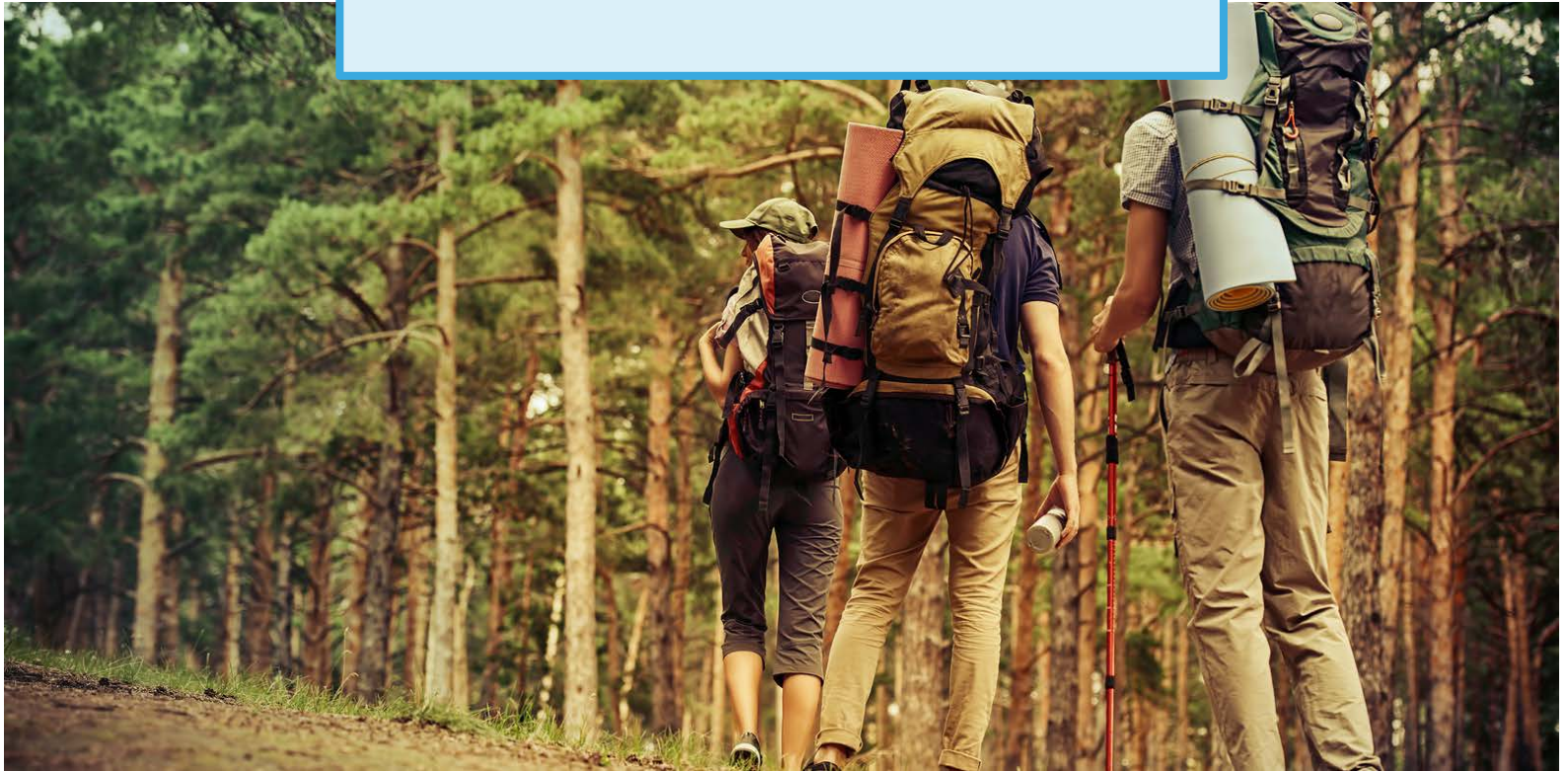
She **skis** down the mountain.

to ice skate



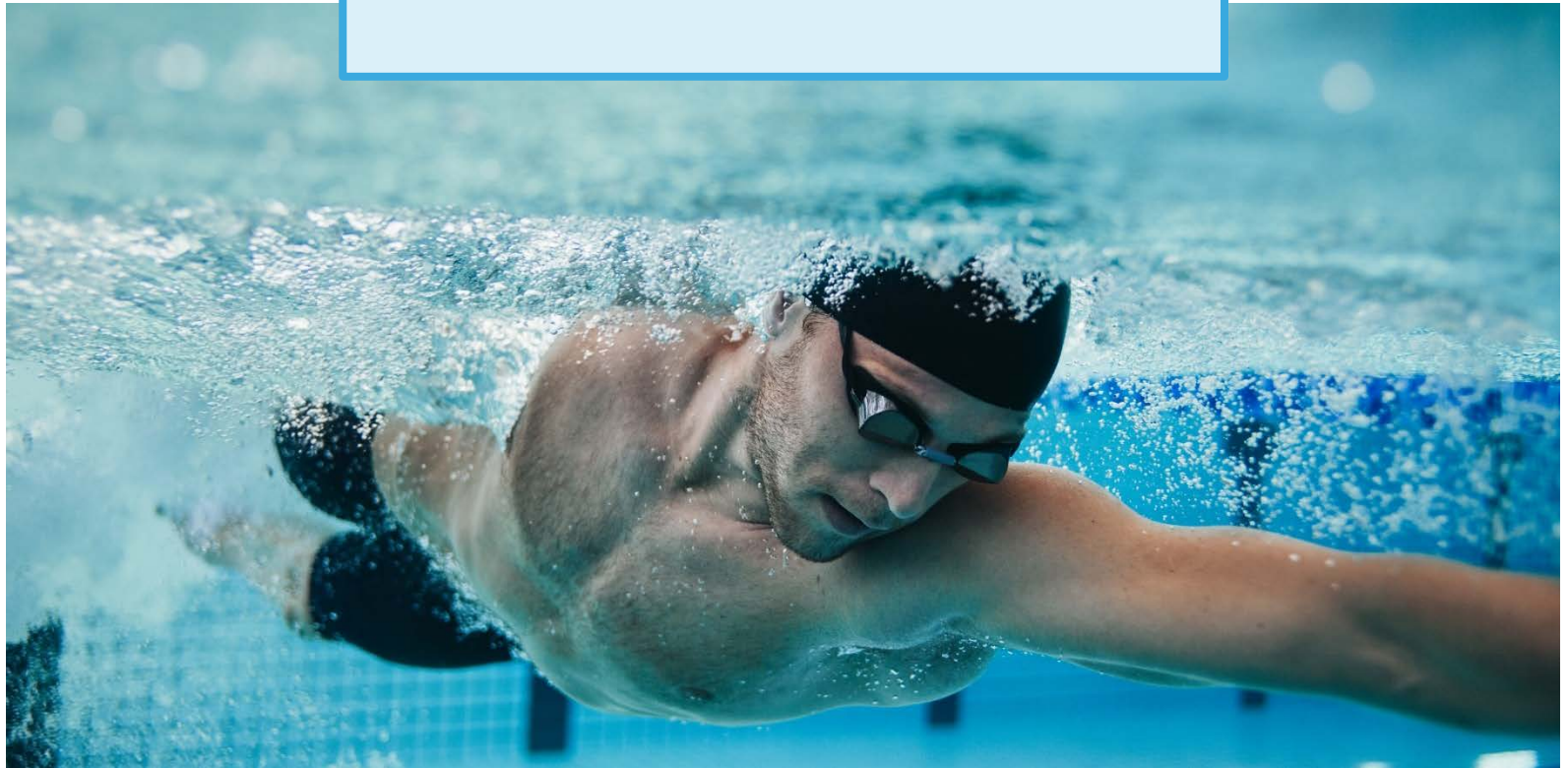
She **ice skates** on the frozen lake.

to hike



They **hike** in the forest with backpacks.

to swim



He **swims** in a pool.

to run



They **run** to stay healthy.



Where do you...?



Do you **swim** in the ocean or in a pool?

Do you **hike** in the forest or in the mountains?





Summer or winter?



I **ice skate** and **ski** in the winter when it is cold and it is snowing.

I **hike** and **run** when it is summer and it is hot and sunny.



I **swim** in the pool in the winter and in the ocean in the summer.

I don't **swim** only in the summer or the winter. I **swim** every month of the year!





I like summer

We can use **like** with nouns.

positive	negative
I like summer.	I don't like winter.
He likes June.	He doesn't like December.



I like to swim

- We can also use **like** and **don't like** with verbs and gerunds.
 - We can use **like** with **to** verbs.
 - We can use **like** with **gerunds**. Gerunds are nouns that take the form of -ing verbs.

positive or negative	-to verb	gerunds (nouns that end with -ing)
I like to swim.	...swimming.
I don't like to hike.	...hiking.
He likes to ski.	...skiing.
He doesn't like to run.	...running.

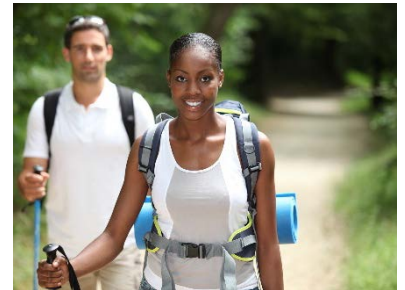

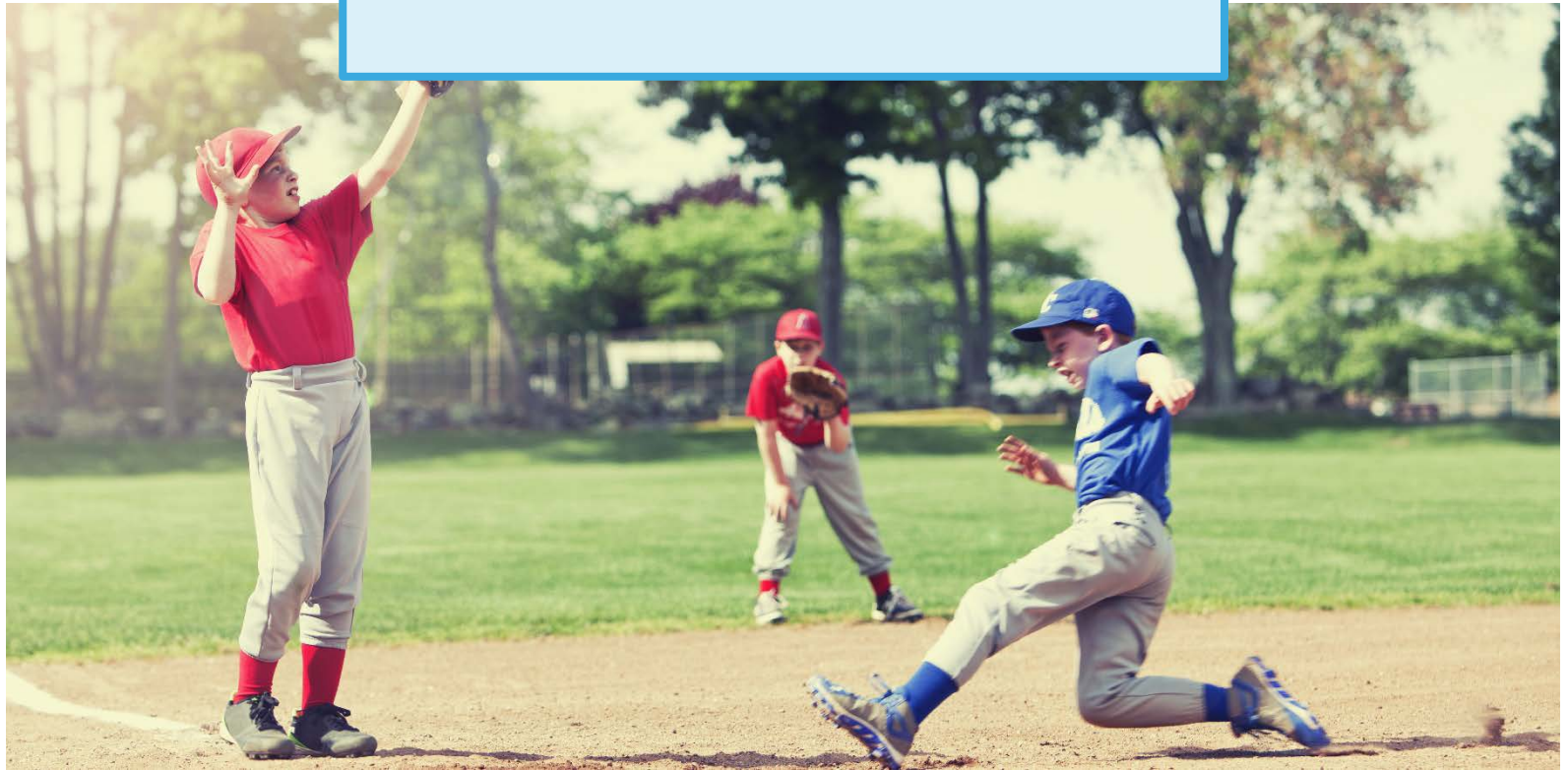

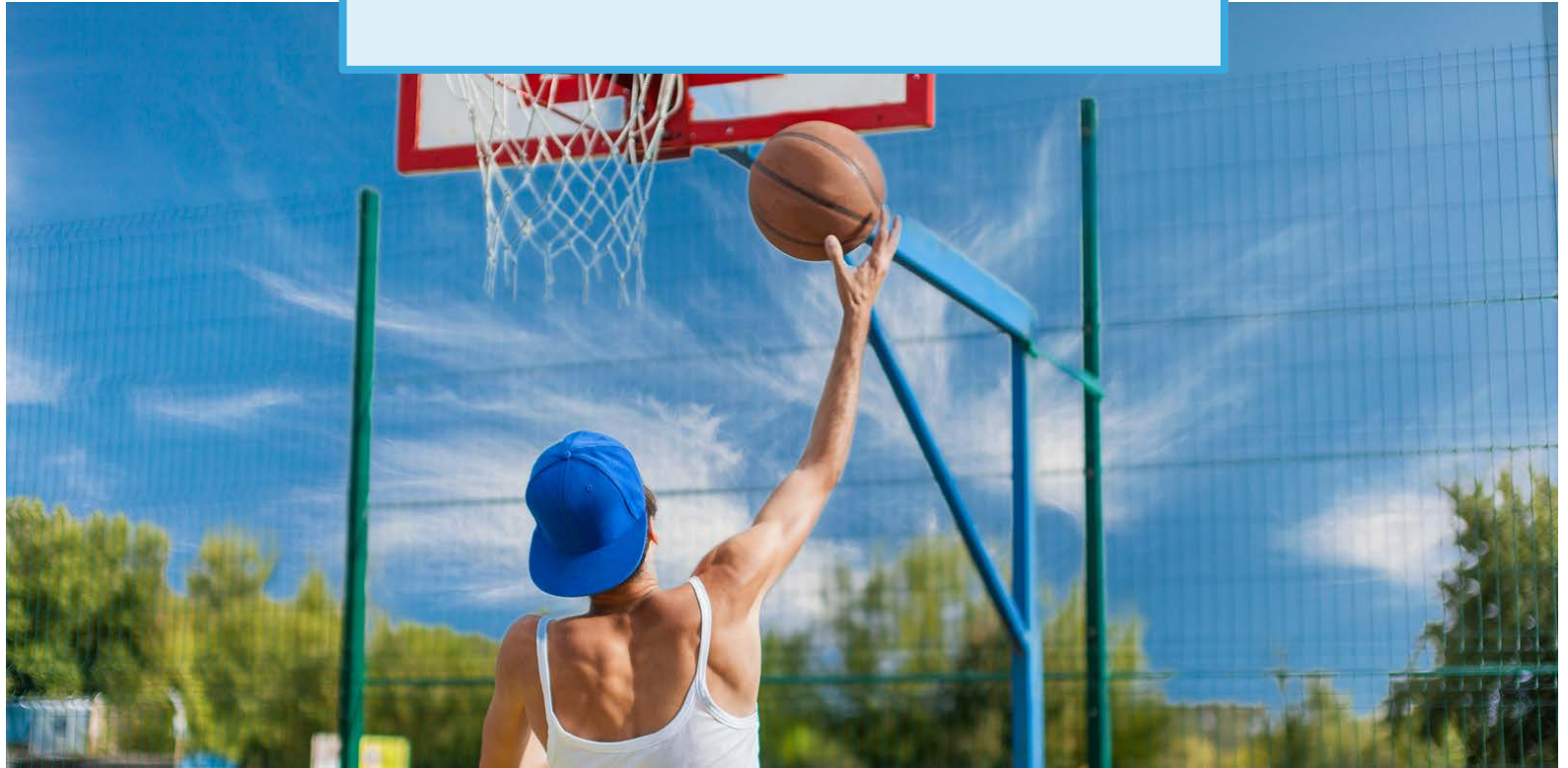
Football uses a black and white ball.

baseball



Baseball uses bats and gloves.

basketball



Basketball uses a basket with a net.

volleyball



Volleyball also uses a net and a ball.

tennis



Tennis uses a racket and a small ball.



How many players?



There are nine players in each **baseball** team.

There are six players in each **volleyball** team.





Where do we play...?



We always play **baseball** outside.

We usually play **football** outside.



Sometimes we play **basketball** inside
and sometimes we play **basketball**
outside.

Sometimes we play **volleyball** on the
beach!





I play basketball

We use **play** with **sport** that does not have their own verb. We can also use **go** with a sport that has its own verb.

play	sport with its own verb	go
I play tennis.	I run .	I go running.
I like playing tennis.	I like running .	I like going running.
He plays basketball.	He swims .	I go swimming.
He likes playing basketball.	He likes swimming .	I like going swimming.



I like basketball

- We can use **like** with nouns.
- We can use **like** with verbs.
 - We can use **like** with **to** verbs.
 - We can use **like** with **gerunds**.

with nouns	with <i>to</i> verbs	with gerunds
I like football.	I like to play football.	I like playing football.
She likes volleyball.	She likes to play volleyball.	She likes playing volleyball.
We don't like basketball.	We don't like to play basketball.	We don't like playing basketball.
He doesn't like tennis.	He doesn't like to play tennis.	He doesn't like playing tennis.

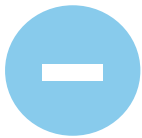


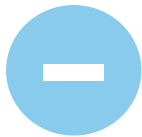

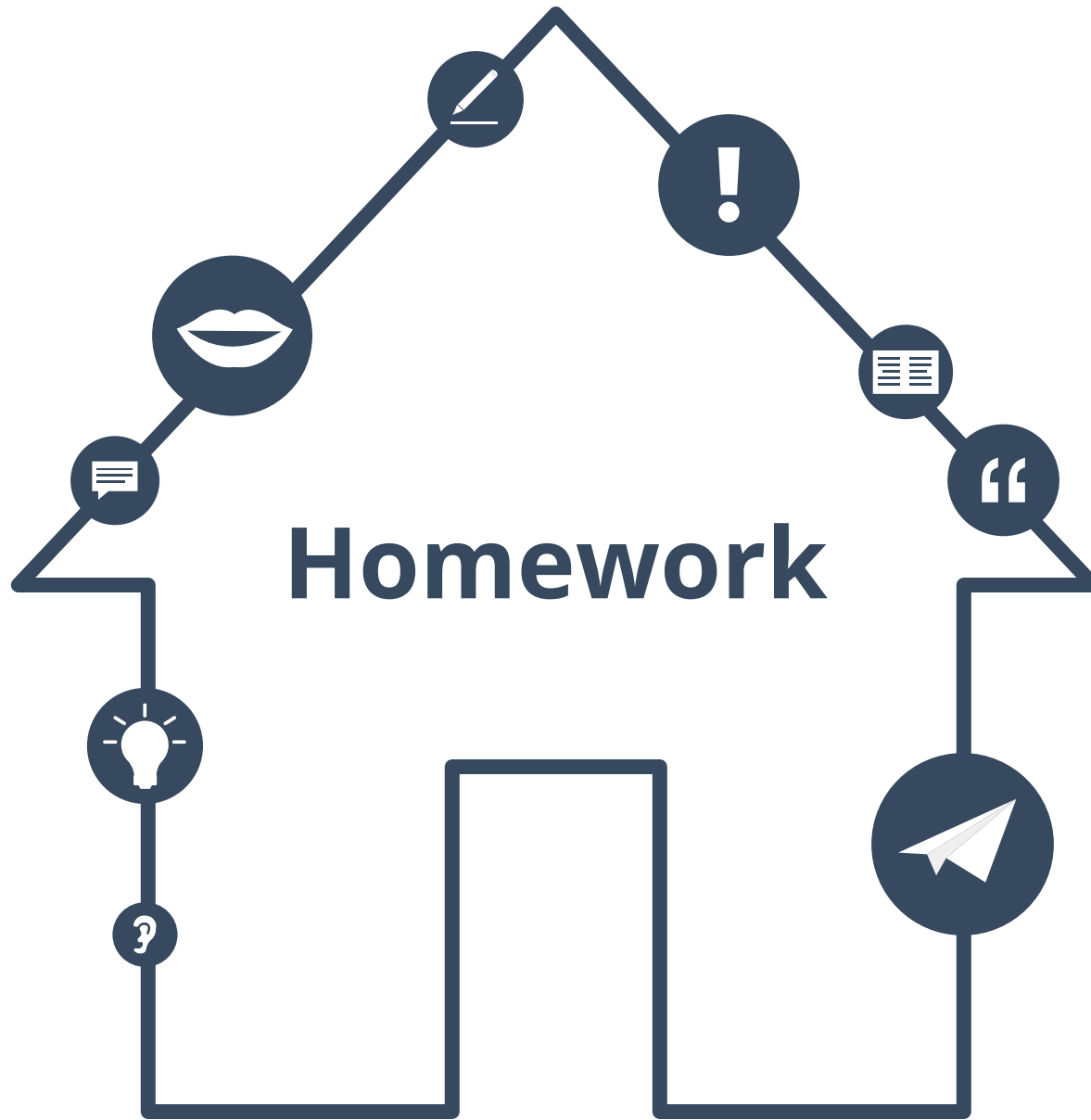
