

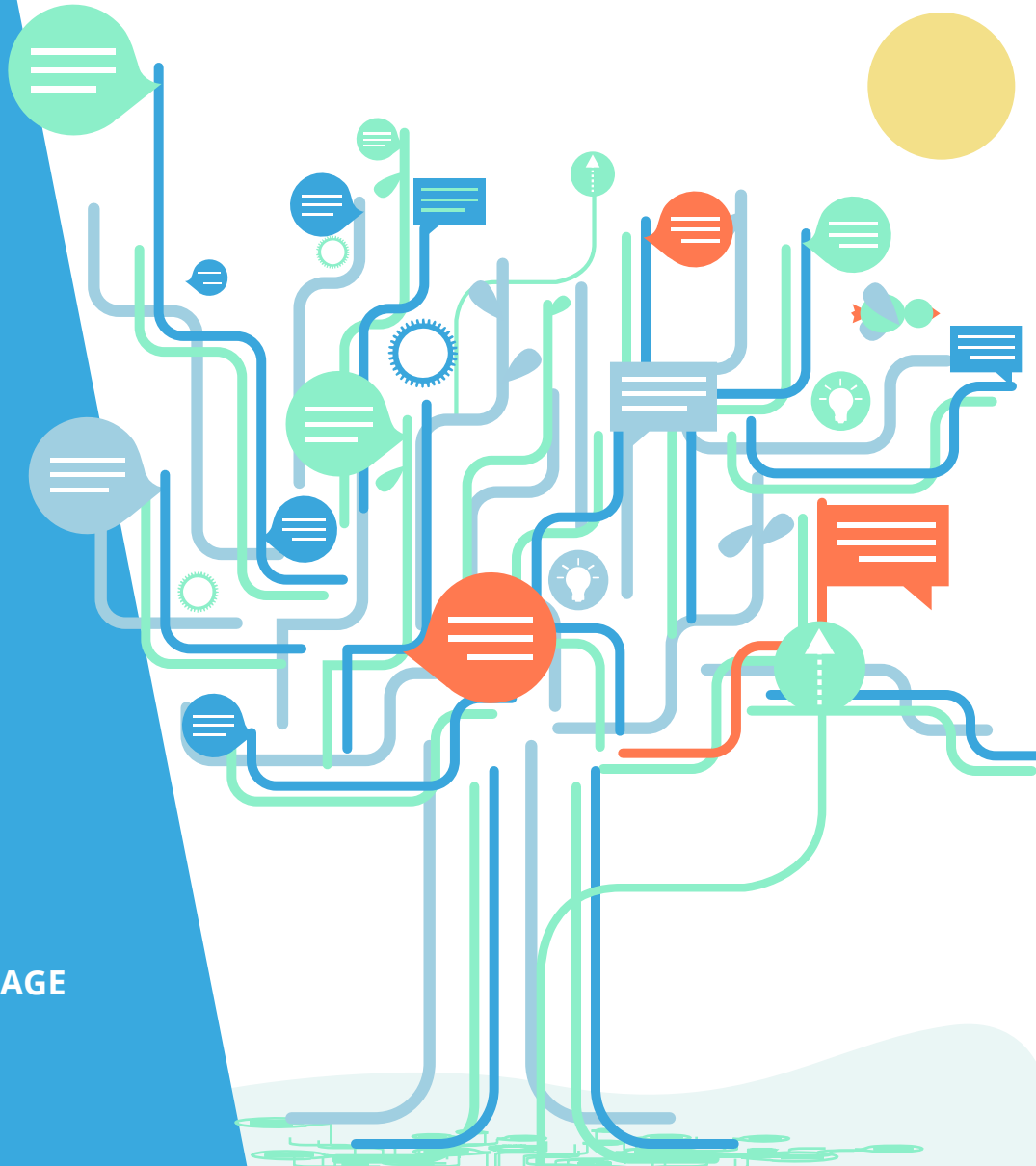

I agree, I hope the **sun** comes out.



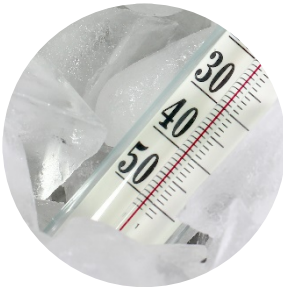


## Temperature change
