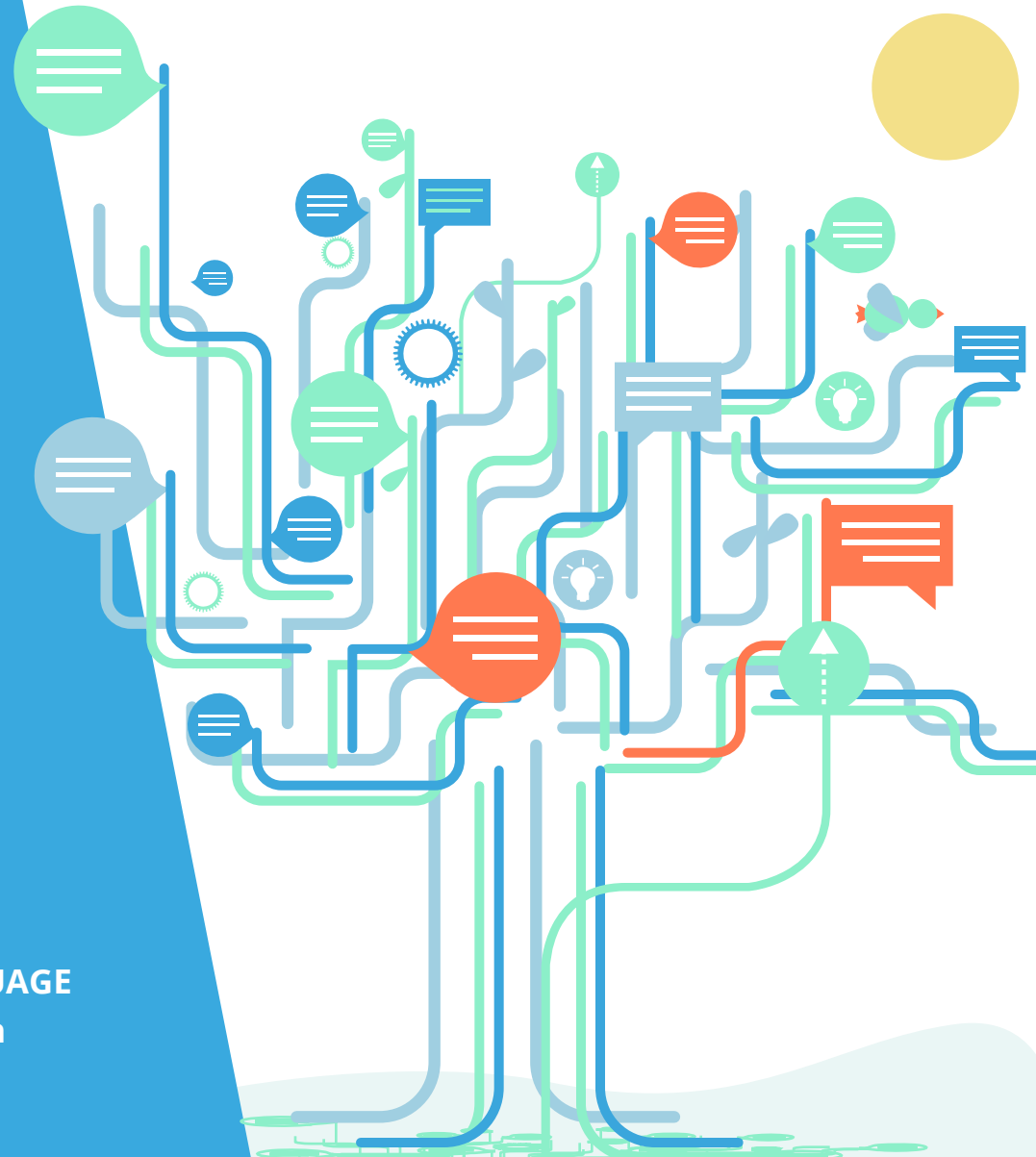

## a doctor's appointment



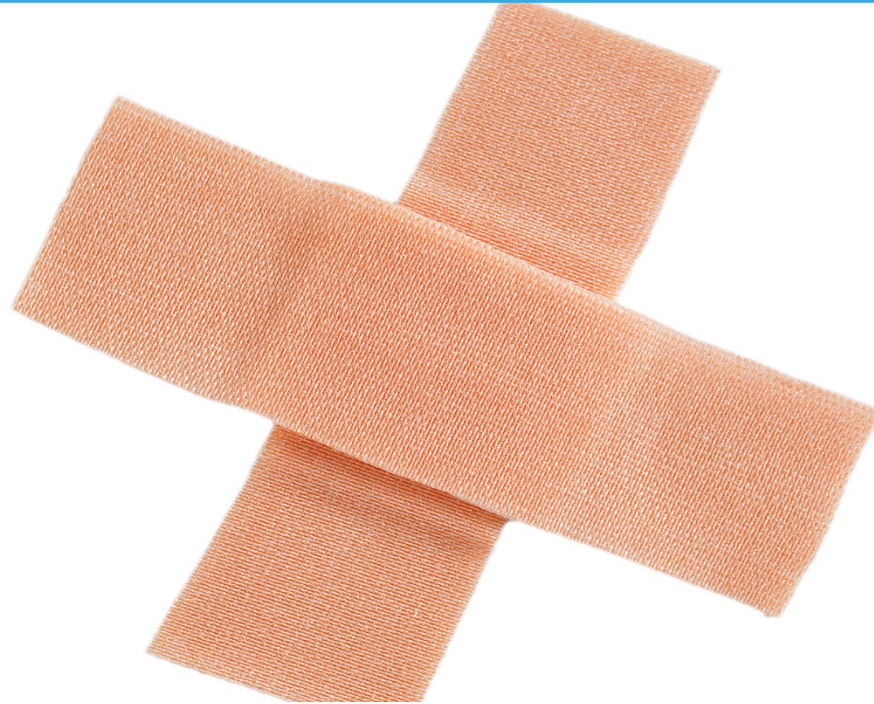
I am ill, and need to make **a doctor's appointment.**

health clinic



My doctor works at the **health clinic**.

plaster



**Plasters** are for small injuries.



medicine



Medication and pills are kinds of **medicine**.

**pill**



A **pill** is a kind of medication.





## Going to the doctor



I am calling to make **a doctor's appointment.**

My **appointment** is at the **health clinic.**





## Talking about health



I need to take a **pill** twice a day.

Can I make a **doctor's appointment** for  
Tuesday?



It is not a big injury, so I only need a  
**plaster**.

My doctor uses **medicine** to make me  
better.

## Forming expressions with *make*

- We use the verb **make** in many expressions in English.

I make...	a doctor's appointment.
He makes...	a phone call.
They make...	dinner.





## Forming expressions with *make*

- Use **make + object pronoun** to talk about how something feels.

It	makes me	sad.
It	makes him	happy.
Vegetables	make you	healthy.
Dairy	makes her	ill.

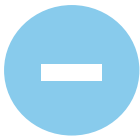

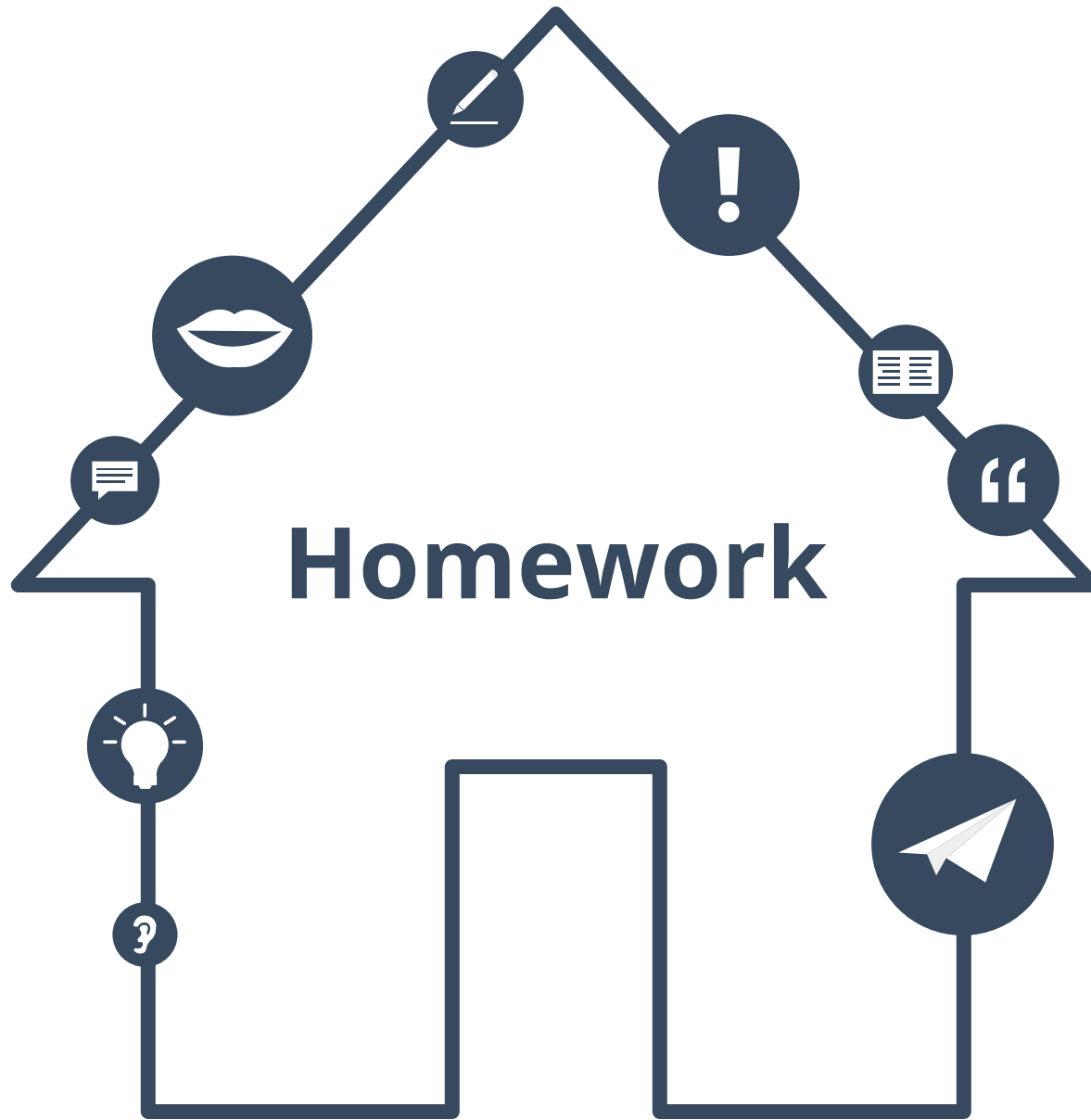

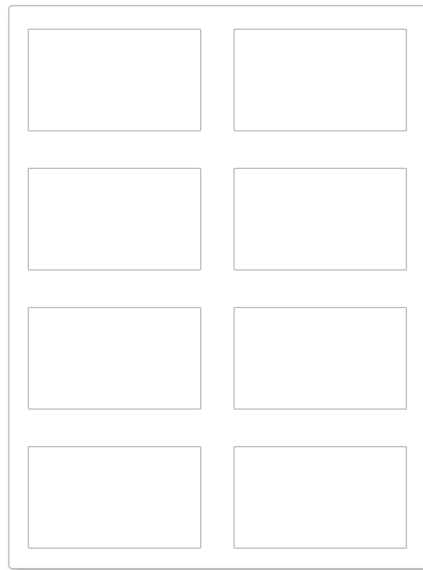
