

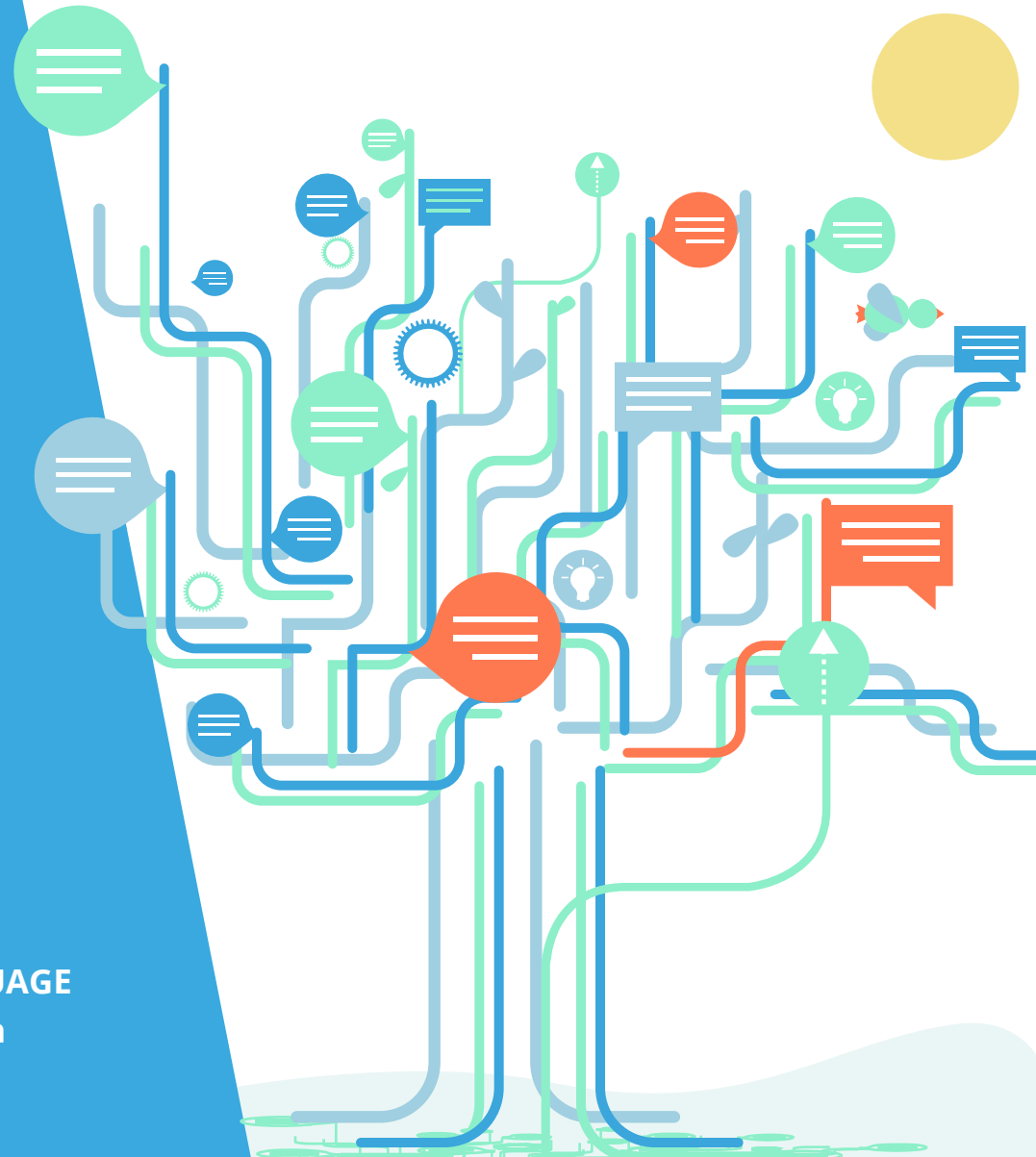

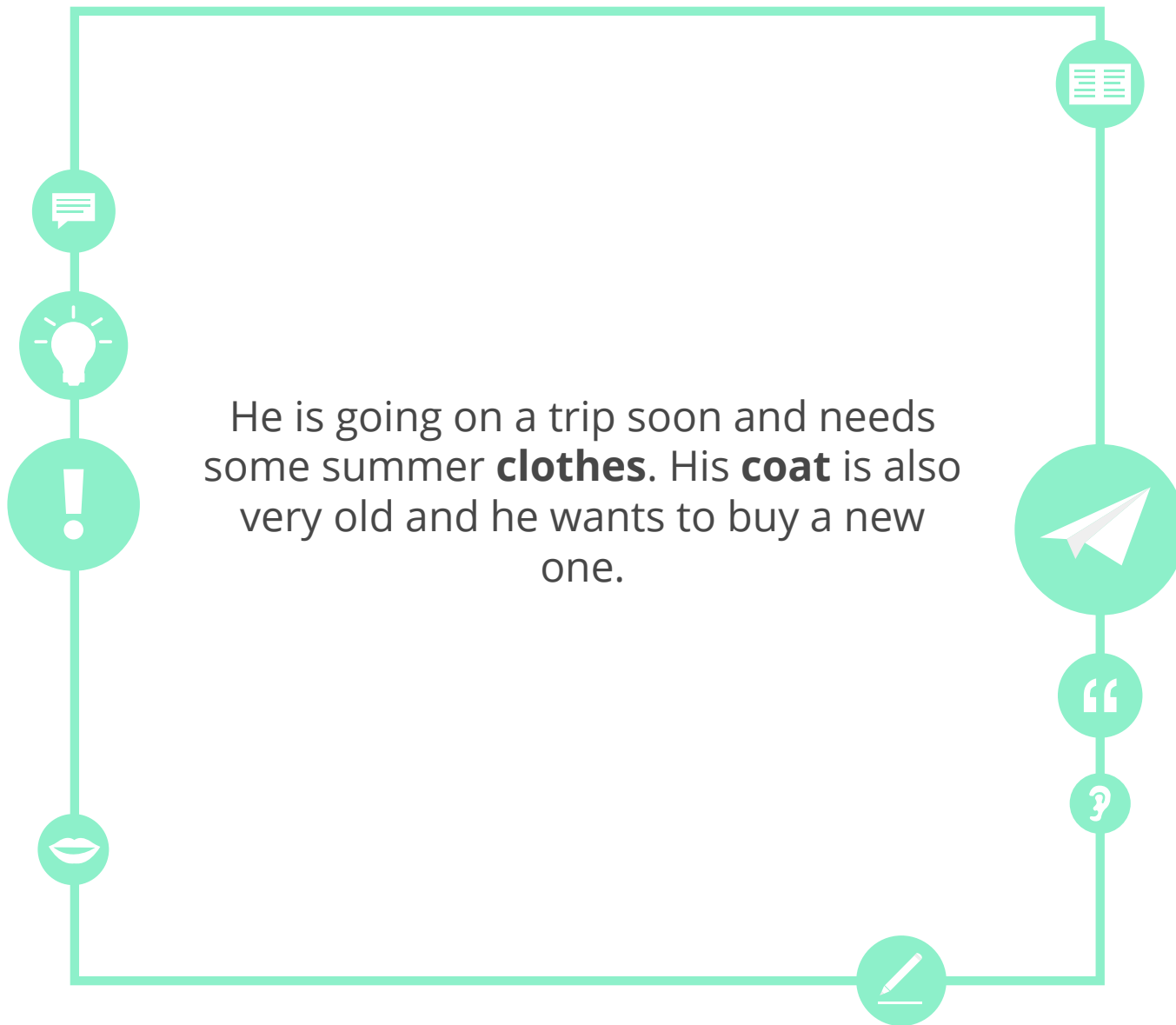


## Goals

## Buying a coat

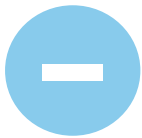
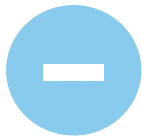

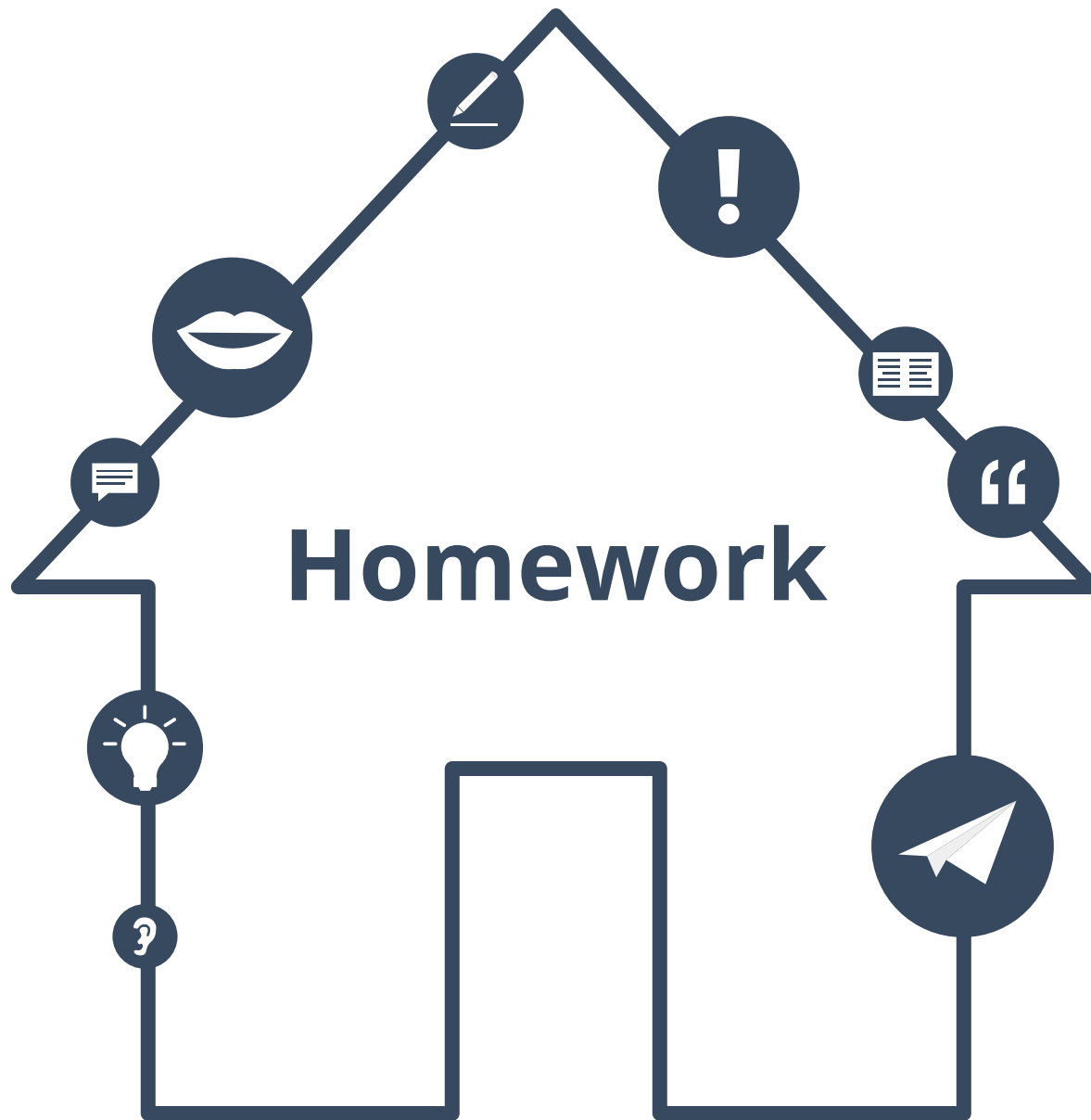
