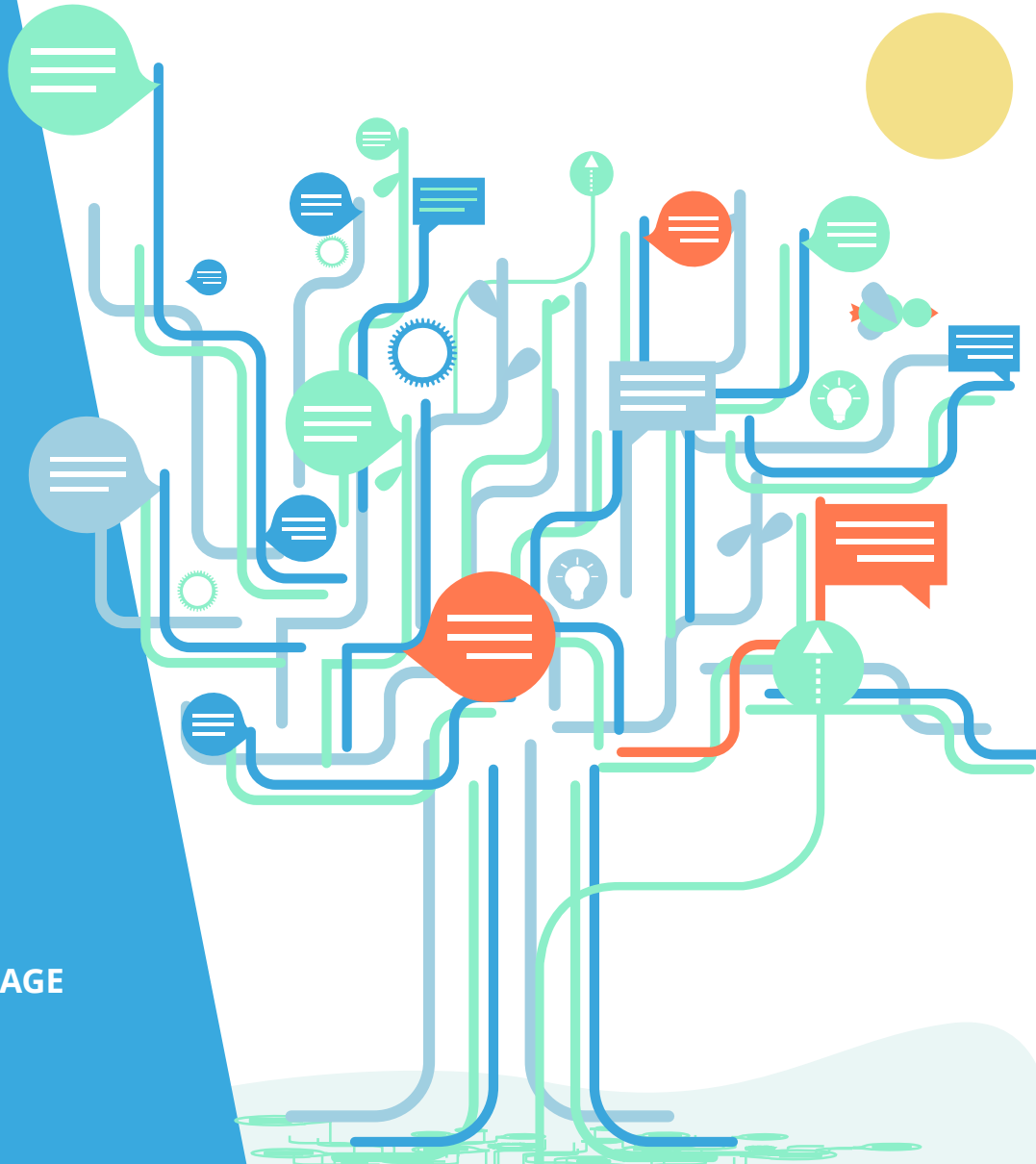

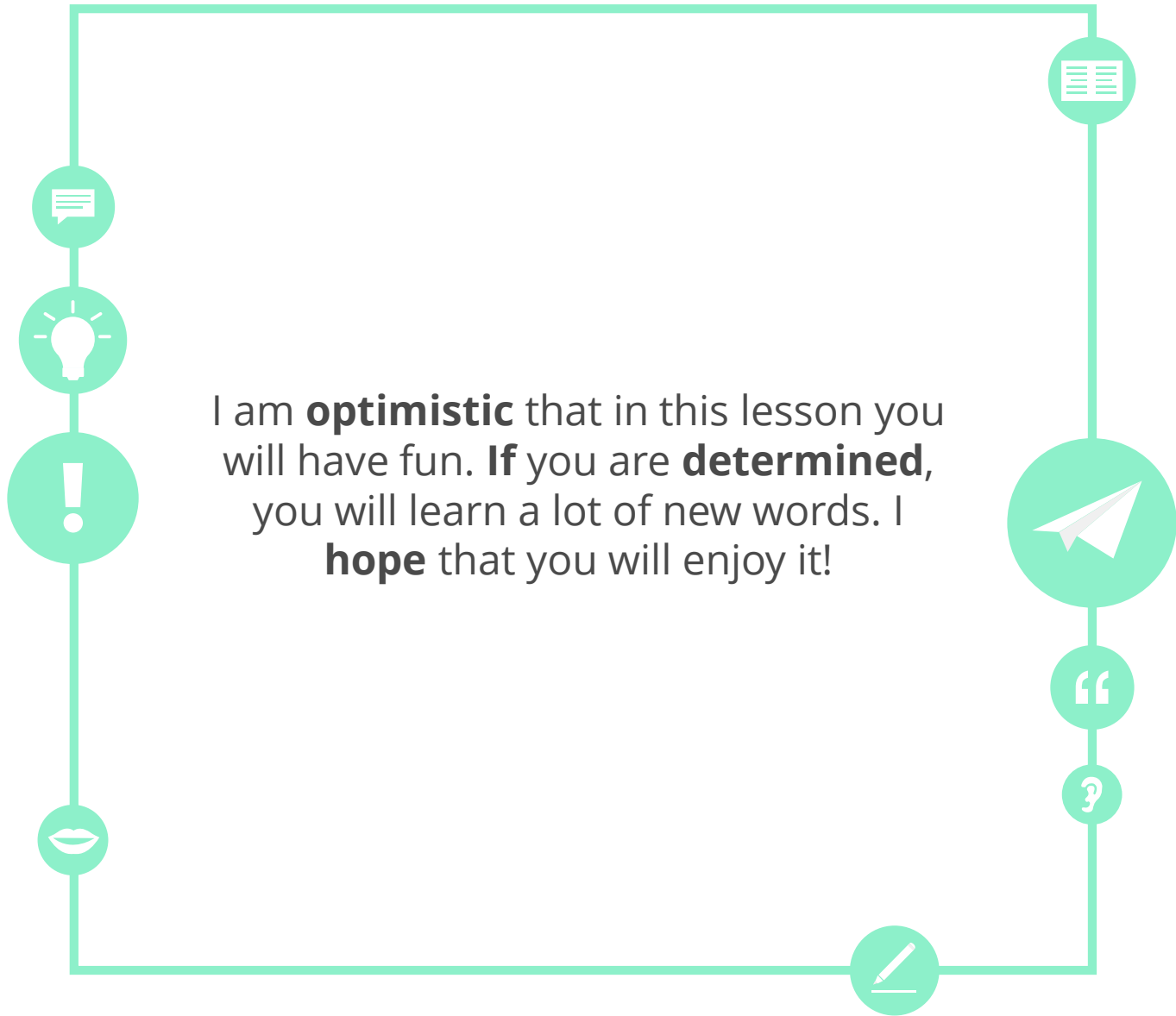


Goals
