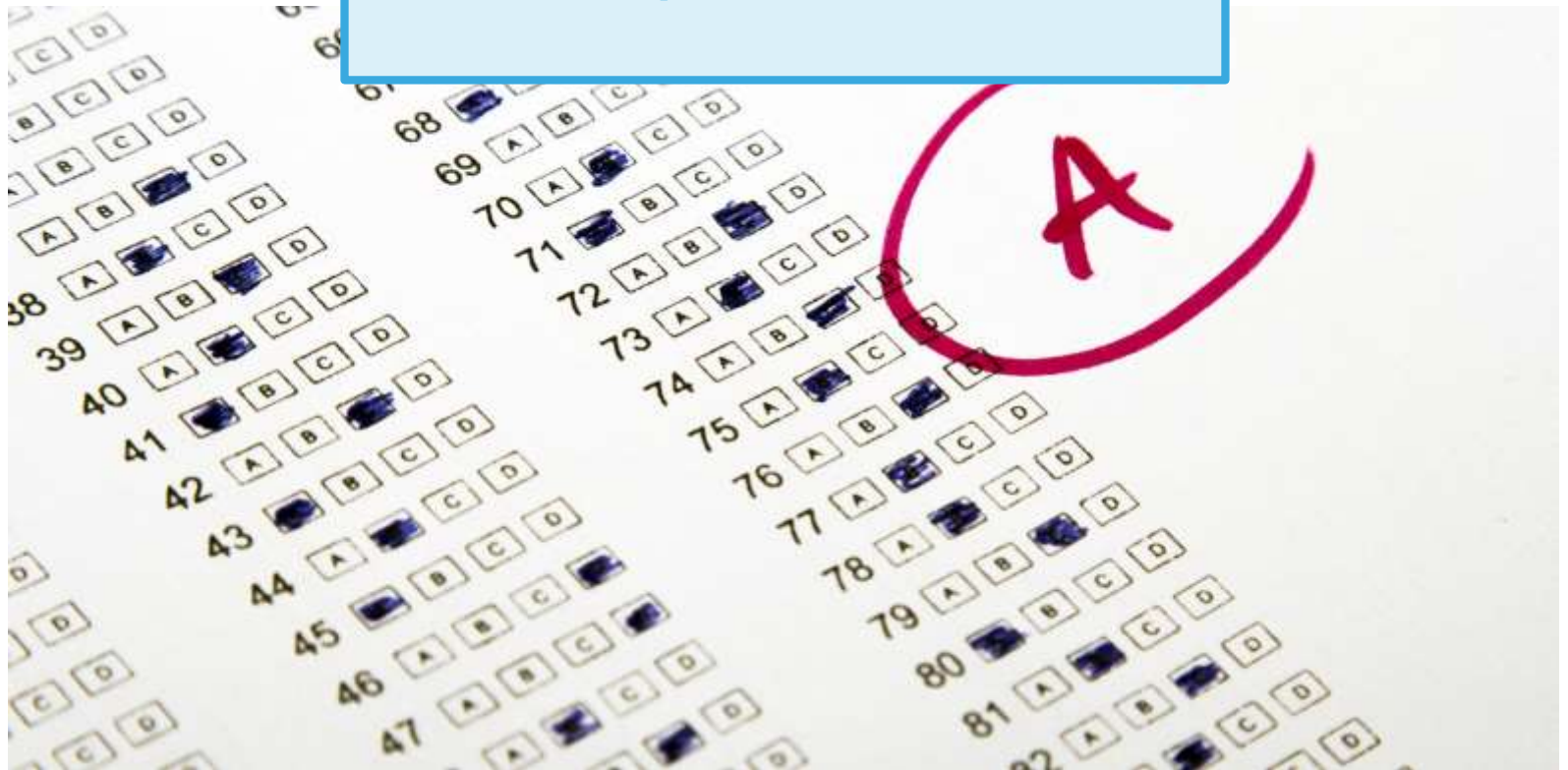
People do **research** to learn new things.

institute



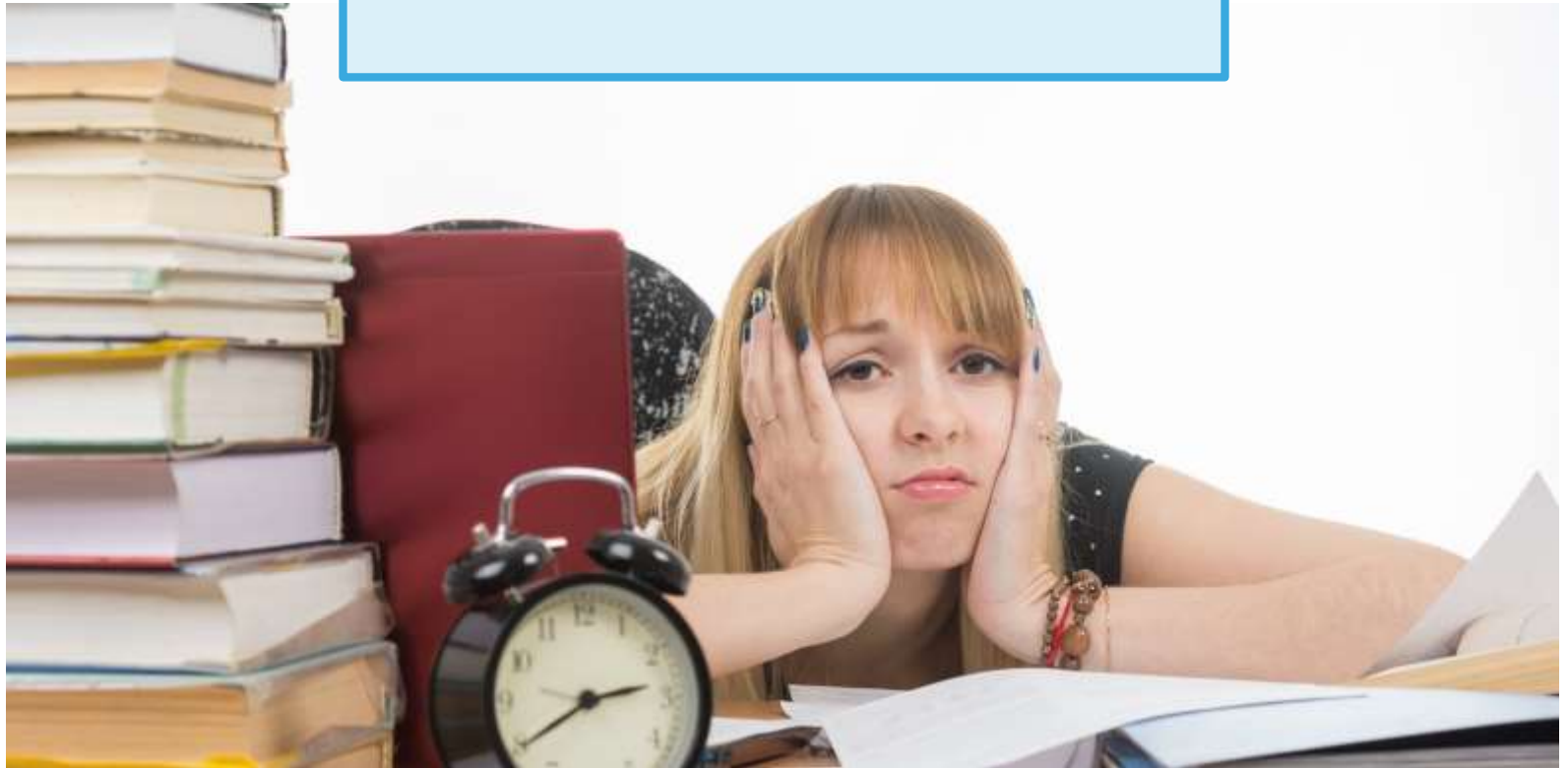
An **institute** is a place where people do research.
