

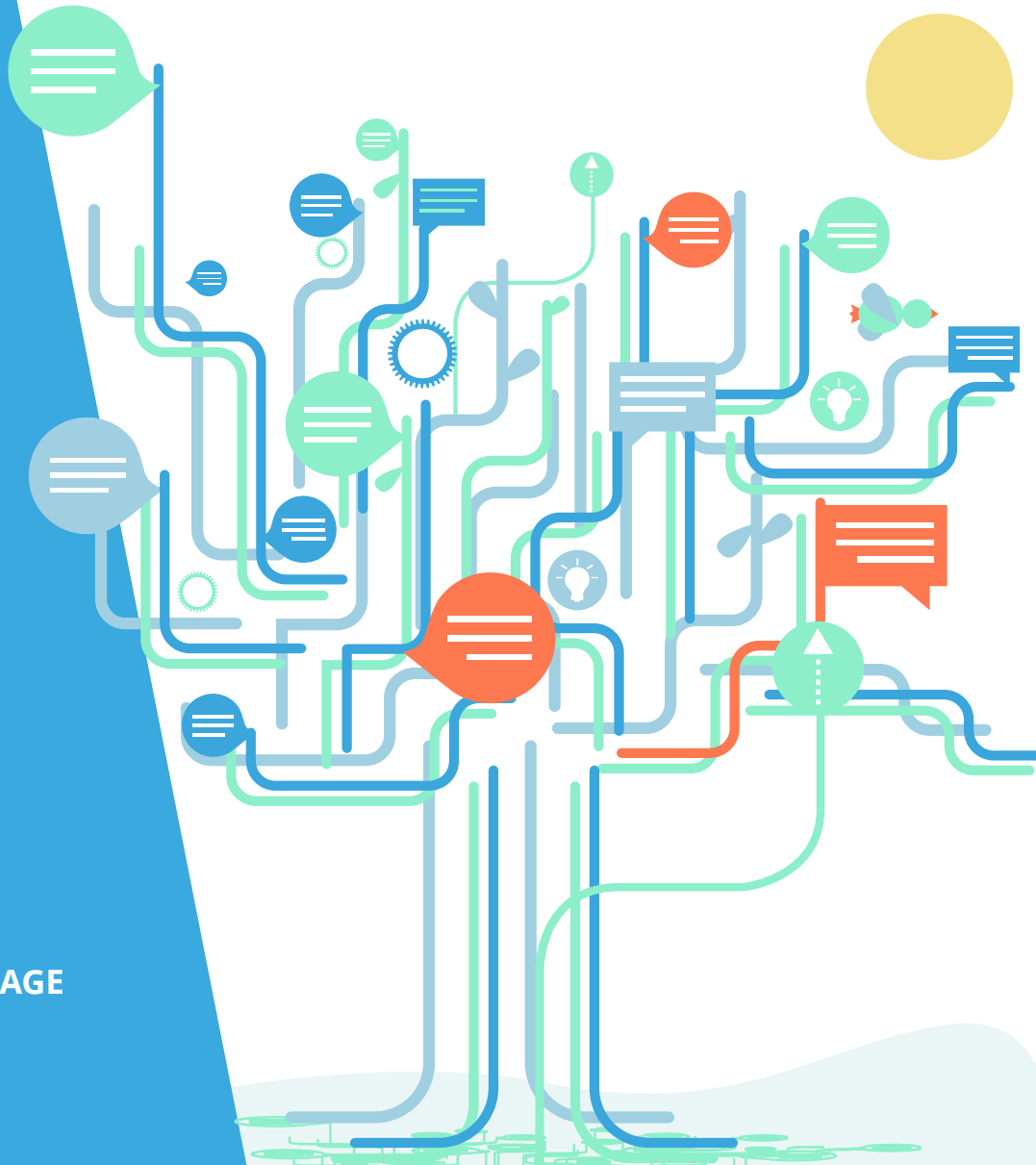



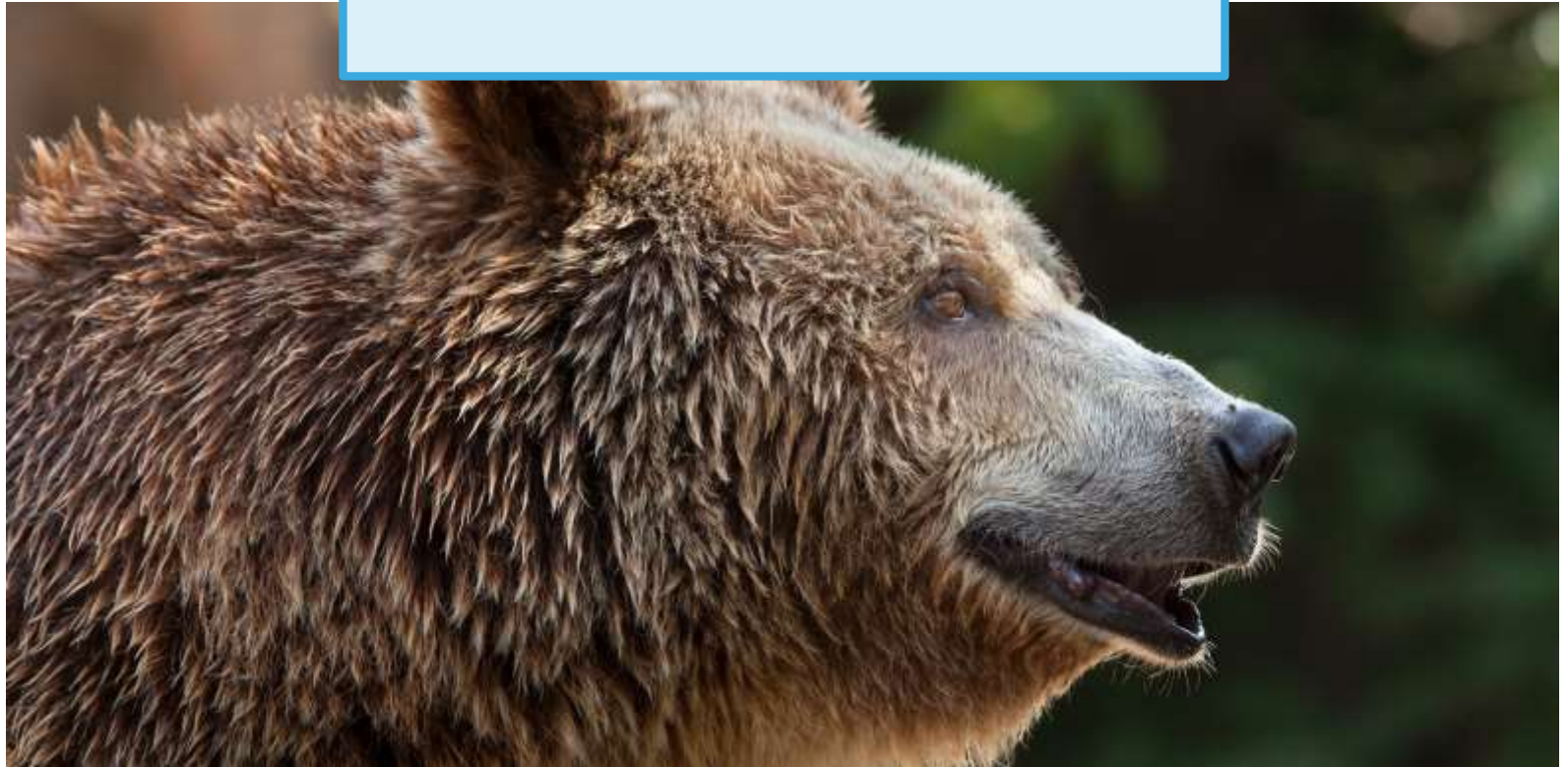
**Lions** live in Africa.

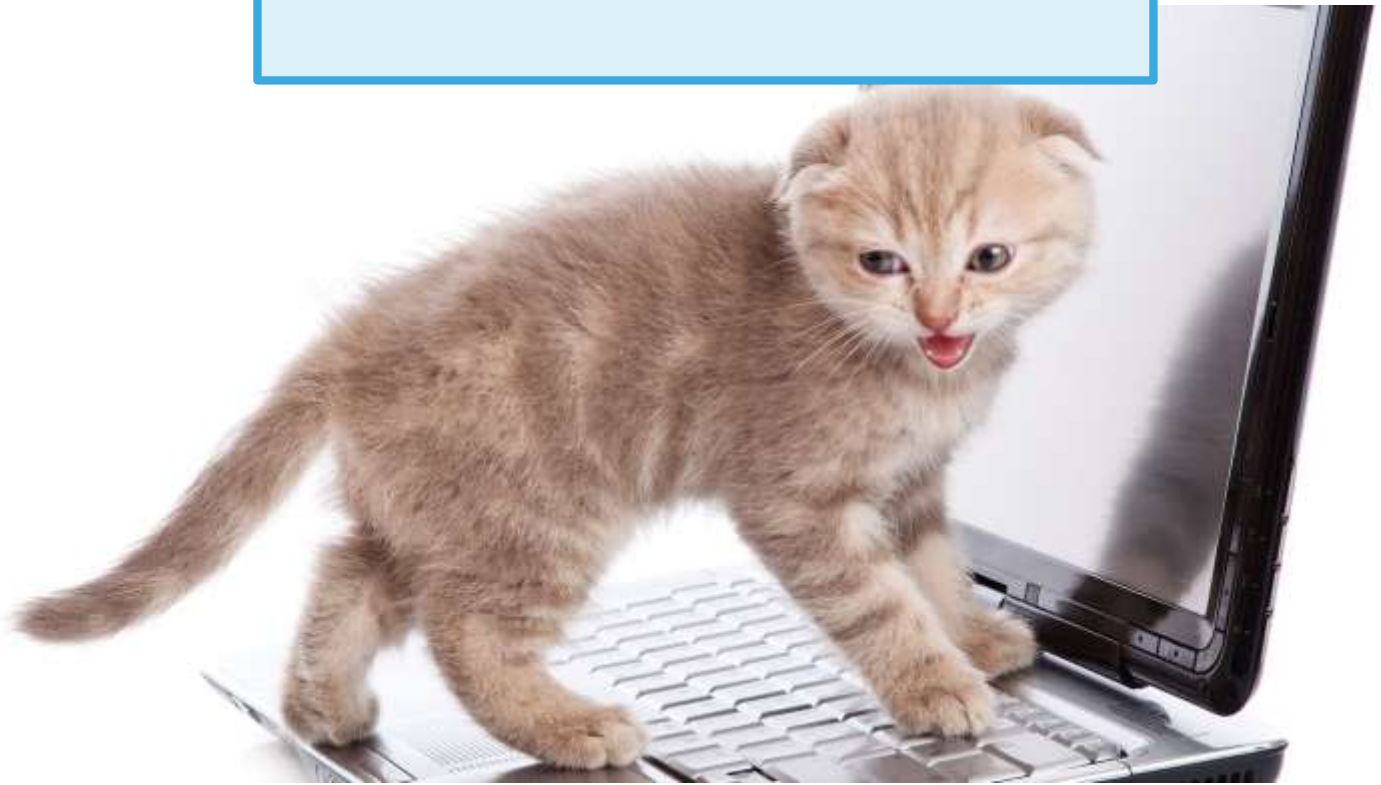

## World animals

If you go to Europe you are sure to see some farms and animals when you travel around. The most common are cows, from which we get milk and beef, and sheep, from which we get wool. Farmers spend a lot of time looking after these animals, feeding them and taking them to the vet when they are sick. There are many wild animals in Europe but most of them are not dangerous to humans – there are some bears and wolves in Eastern Europe but they are very rare. There are a lot more dangerous predators in the wild if you go to Asia or Africa, and in North America. They do not hunt humans but they can run very fast, and they will chase you if they are scared or very hungry. The most dangerous animal in the sea is the shark, so be careful if you go swimming in Australia.
